The fact that they are citizens of a particular state does not deprive them of membership to the human family, or of citizenship in the universal society, the common world-wide fellowship of humanity."*

## Understanding Catholic Social Teaching as it relates to Migration

### Five Basic Principles

Although Catholic theology has always promoted human rights rooted in natural law and God's revelation. It was the encyclical, *Rerum Novarum* (On the Condition of Labor) in 1891 that developed a systematic presentation of principles of the rights and responsibilities of people. *Rerum Novarum* commented on the situation of migrants: in latter documents, popes and bishops' conferences have synthesized the Catholic theological tradition to articulate five basic principles on migration.

#### **1. Persons have the right to find opportunities in their homeland.**

All persons have the right to find in their own countries the economic, political and social opportunities to live in dignity and achieve a full life through the use of their God-given gifts. In this context, work that provides a just, living wage is a basic human need.

#### **2. Persons have the right to migrate to support themselves and their families.**

The Church recognizes that all goods of the earth belong to all people. When persons cannot find employment in their country of origin to support themselves and their families, they have a right to find work elsewhere in order to survive. Sovereign nations should produce ways to accommodate this right.

#### **3. Sovereign nations have the right to control their borders.**

The Church recognizes the right of sovereign nations to control their territories but rejects such control when it is exerted merely for the purpose of acquiring additional wealth. More powerful economic nations, which have the ability to protect and feed their residents, have a stronger obligation to accommodate migration flows.

#### **4. Refugee and asylum seekers should be afforded protection.**

Those who flee wars and persecution should be protected by the global community. This requires, at a minimum, that migrants have a right to claim refugee status without incarceration and to have their claims full considered by a competent authority.

#### **5. The human dignity and human rights of undocumented migrants should be respected.**

Regardless of their legal status, migrants, like all persons, possess inherent human dignity that should be respected. Often they are subject to punitive laws and harsh treatment from enforcement officers from both receiving and transit countries. Government policies that respect the basic human rights of the undocumented are necessary.

The Catholic Church teaches that every person has basic human rights and is entitled to have basic human needs met— food, shelter, clothing, education and health care. Undocumented persons are particularly vulnerable to exploitation by unscrupulous employers and they sometimes do not complain for fear of discovery and deportation. Current immigration policy that criminalizes the mere attempts to immigrate and imprisons immigrants who have committed on crime or who have already served a just sentence for a crime is immoral. In the Bible, God promises that our judgment will be based on our treatment of the most vulnerable. Before God we cannot excuse inhumane treatment of certain persons by claiming that their lack of legal status deprives them of rights given by the Creator.

*Es una gran oportunidad para hacer planes juntos y conocerse y tratarse más, planifica.*

1. **Flexibilidad dentro de un orden:** Aunque estemos de vacaciones, es importante no perder del todo los hábitos adquiridos durante el invierno. Para eso, establece un horario, pero con flexibilidad y margen: estamos en una nueva situación, en otro contexto.
2. **Hacer actividades en familia:** Aunque cada uno tendrá sus gustos y sus planes, es importante encontrar tiempo para hacer cosas todos juntos: cocinar, pasear, ir en bici, hacer excursiones, visitar nuestra ciudad...
3. **Gratitud:** el ambiente relajado del verano es perfecto para impulsar el agradecimiento, que a veces con las prisas queda un poco en el olvido. Saber dar las gracias a los demás por los detalles, por los planes o por haberlo pasado bien juntos.
4. **Disfrutar de pequeñas cosas:** El plan perfecto no tiene por qué ser caro o extravagante. Hay que enseñar desde niños a disfrutar con las cosas pequeñas como, por ejemplo, ver una puesta de sol, tomar un helado, etc.
5. **Abrirse a los demás:** Estar todo el día nosotros con nosotros mismos puede resultar poco enriquecedor. El verano es la época perfecta para abrirnos a los demás: ve por delante invitando a tus amigos a casa y enseña a tus hijos a hacer lo mismo.
6. **Actividades culturales:** Educar el gusto de los más pequeños no tiene por qué ser aburrido si se elige y se prepara bien: estudia las posibilidades culturales de tu zona y visita algunos museos, monumentos o exposiciones.
7. **Tiempo para leer:** La lectura es un viaje gratis que alimenta las neuronas de grandes y pequeños: novelas de aventuras, biografías, cuentos... Busca una biblioteca cercana y ¡a elegir!
8. **Visitar a familiares y personas necesitadas:** Durante el curso, bien por tiempo o por distancias, a veces es difícil visitar a la familia: abuelos, primos, tíos... Además, también pueden hacerse visitas a personas enfermas o más necesitadas.
9. **Idiomas:** Deja de lado los formatos más académicos y acostumbra a toda la familia a ver series o películas en versión original, ¡a ver quién entiende antes!
10. **Dar gracias a Dios por pasarlo bien y estar juntos.**
