LAS LECTURAS DE LA MISA DE HOY

A ti, Señor levanto mi alma: Dios mío, en ti confío, no quede yo desfraudado que no triunfen de mí mis enemigos; pues los que esperan en ti no quedan desfraudados.

Primera lectura - Isaías 2:1-5:

Dirán: «Venid, subamos al monte de Señor, a la Casa del Dios de Jacob, para que él nos enseñe sus caminos y nosotros sigamos sus senderos.»

Salmo 122: Que alegría cuando me dijeron: «¡Oh, qué alegría cuando me dijeron: ¡Vamos a la Casa del Señor!

Segunda Lectura - Romanos 13:11-14:

“Nada de comilonas y borracheras; nada de lujurias y desenfrenos; nada de rivalidades y envidias”.

Lectura del Santo Evangelio San Mateo 24, 37-44:

“Velad, pues, porque no sabéis qué día vendrá vuestro Señor”.

La intención de la misa del día de hoy es por el alma de **PLINIO MEDRANO**

El primer domingo de Adviento es el primer día del Nuevo Año Litúrgico para la Iglesia Católica. Jesús nos invita a vigilar”.

Asimismo, las lecturas bíblicas de esta primera semana y la predicación son una invitación a estar vigilantes para cuando venga el Señor. Por ello, es importante que en las familias se haga un propósito que les permita avanzar en el camino hacia la Navidad.

El tiempo de Adviento, que es el primer período del Año Litúrgico, tiene una duración de cuatro semanas, comienza este domingo 27 de noviembre y se prolonga hasta el 24 de diciembre.

Las lecturas son las correspondientes al Ciclo A.

El término “**Adviento**” viene del latín adventus, que significa venida, llegada. El color usado en la liturgia de la Iglesia durante este tiempo es el morado. Con el Adviento comienza un nuevo año litúrgico en la Iglesia. El sentido del Adviento es avivar en los creyentes la espera del Señor.

Primera Parte del Adviento: Nos habla sobre la venida del Señor al final de los tiempos.

Segunda Parte del Adviento: Desde el 18 de diciembre al 24 de diciembre, es la llamada “Semana Santa” de la

Navidad, y se orienta a preparar más explícitamente la venida de Jesucristo en las historias, la Navidad.

1er domingo (vela Morada), 2º domingo (vela Morada), 3er domingo (vela rosada), 4º Domingo (vela morada): -Su forma circular es el signo del Amor de Dios. -Las ramas verdes representan al Cristo vivo -Las velas color morado representan el espíritu de vigilia, penitencia y sacrificio que debemos tener para prepararnos adecuadamente para la llegada de Cristo. -La vela rosada representa (Alegría), el gozo que sentimos ante la cercanía del

nacimiento del Señor.

Las velas permiten reflexionar la oscuridad provocada por el pecado que ciega al hombre y lo aleja de Dios. Después de la primera caída del hombre, Dios fue dando poco a poco una esperanza de salvación que iluminó todo el universo, como las velas de la Corona.

Así como las tinieblas se disipan con cada vela que encendemos, los siglos se van iluminando cada vez más con la cercana llegada de Cristo al mundo.

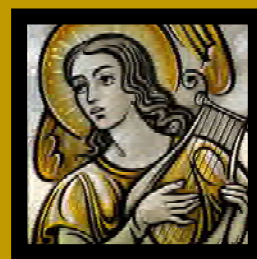

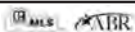

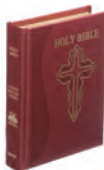
