5. Other students in the College of Natural Sciences majoring in forestry, environmental science or arboriculture.

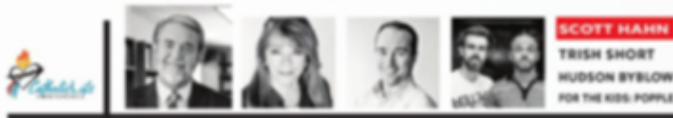
**Letter from the Bishop must be sent to the UMass Foundation Scholarship Committee for application to be considered.

JOHN "HAPPY" HOULIHAN
BASKETBALL & BASEBALL COACH



From 1927 to 1934 his boy's basketball team won 160 and lost 35 games, winning 18 different titles. In the parochial league, which consisted of Cathedral, St. Michael's, St. Jerome's, Sacred Heart, Rosary and St. Mary's, the team won 35 out of 36 games between 1927 and 1931.
