

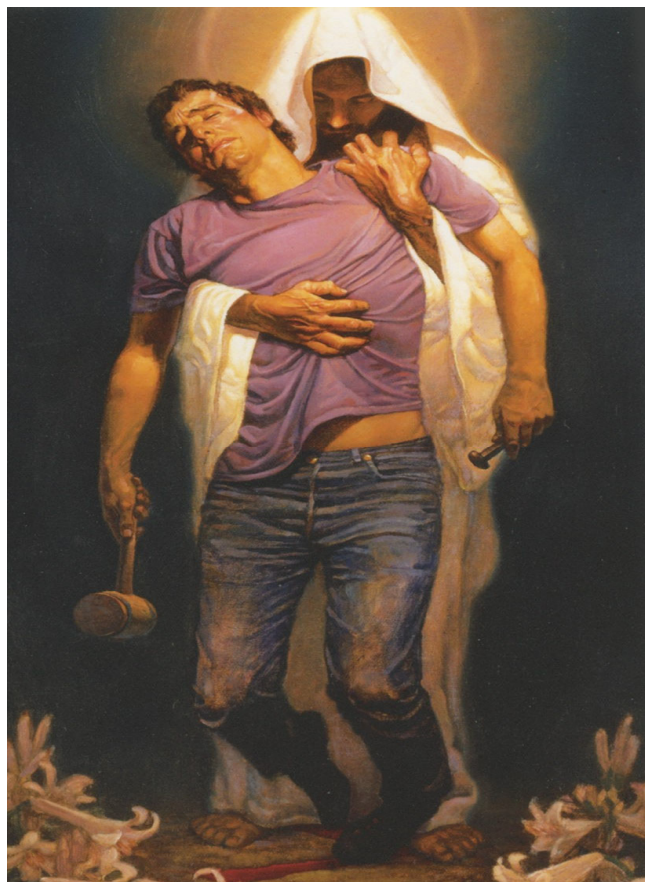

100th Anniversary of the Third Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima — July 13, 1917 — 2017

July 13, 1917 – THIRD APPARITION — Part 2

“YOU HAVE SEEN HELL WHERE THE SOULS OF POOR SINNERS GO...”

The description of this third apparition is taken from the book written **by Sr. Lucia, in her own words:**

So on July 13th, 1917, after a few introductory exchanges between Lucia and the beautiful Lady, Lucia then explained their vision of HELL (see last week's bulletin for Part 1 of the vision the Fatima children had seen).

“Terrified [at the vision of hell] and as if to plead for succor, we looked up at Our Lady, who said to us, kindly and so sadly... Our Lady then explains the following....

“You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. The war is going to end; but if people do not cease offending God, a worse one will break out during the Pontificate of Pius XI. When you see a night illumined by an unknown light, know that this is a great sign given to you by God that He is about to punish the world for its crimes, by means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and of the Holy Father.”

Our Lady explains how to prevent...

“To prevent this, I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion of Reparation on First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace; if not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer, various nations will be annihilated. In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she will be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world. In Portugal, the dogma of the Faith will always be preserved. Do not tell this to anybody. Francisco, yes, you may tell him.”

Our Lady requests the following prayer.... ***“When you pray the Rosary, say after each mystery: “O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who are most in need.”***

After this, there was a moment of silence and then I asked: “Is there any more you want of me?” ***“No, I do not want anything more of you today.”***

Then, as before, Our Lady began to ascend toward the east, until she finally disappeared in the immense distance of the firmament.

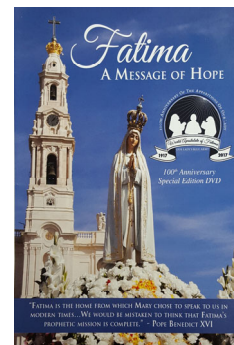
O Immaculate Heart of Mary, true model of every holiness, give us trust to become saints, and pray for us who have recourse to Thee!!!

The 25th Annual Will County Back to School Fair, coordinated by Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet will be held on Thursday, August 3, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Joliet Catholic Academy (1200 N. Larkin Avenue) in Joliet. **Please note that this is a new location this year.**

This annual summer event is a major countywide effort to help families who are living on low-incomes access important services to begin the school year on a positive note. Children who attend the fair will receive free medical and dental services; vital information about local programs and services; and a new backpack with school supplies!

Each child attending the fair must be accompanied by an adult. Parent/guardian **must** bring the following items in order to receive supplies and services for their children at the fair:

- Identification for all household members:
Adults: state I.D. or driver's license; passport; Mexican consulate I.D.
Children: birth certificate, social security card, medical card, Mexican consulate I.D.
- Proof of Income:
Printouts from: public aid, social security, unemployment, food stamp, link card, check stub, or medical card.
- Verification of Address:
Current utility bill and/or government mail showing Will County address

Contact Governor Bruce Rauner to VETO HB 1785

Springfield lawmakers recently passed HB 1785, a highly controversial proposal that would make it significantly easier for gender-dysphoric persons to obtain falsified birth certificates by changing the sex on their birth certificate, which is both a legal and historical document. In turn, this will have consequences with regard to the relentless cultural assault on physical privacy through the sexual integration of previously sex-segregated spaces like restrooms, locker rooms, dressing rooms, shelters, semi-private hospital rooms, nursing home rooms, and prisons.

Take ACTION:

Please contact Governor Bruce Rauner to encourage him to veto HB 1785 and uphold birth certificates as the historical legal documents they were intended to be. Call his office at (217) 782-0244 and/or (312) 814-2121.

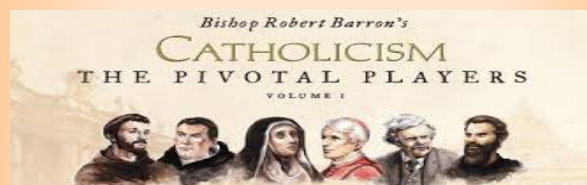

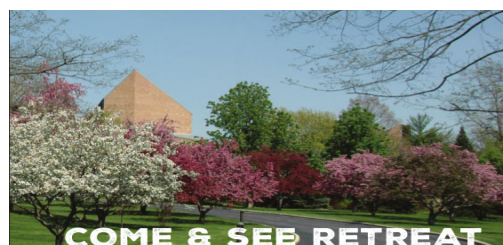


Vocations Discernment Retreat

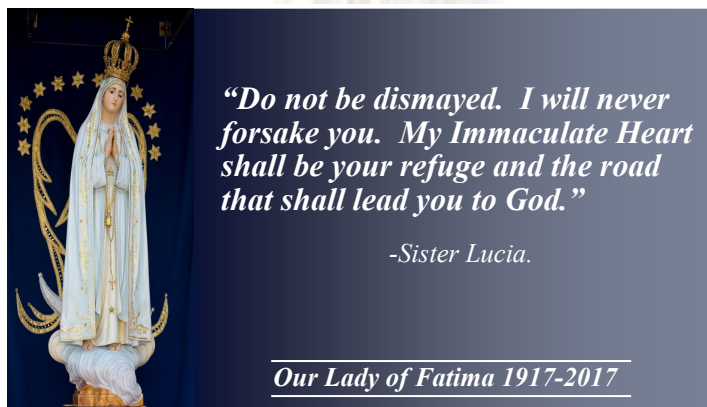

Fatima Plenary Indulgence

Pope Francis has granted a special Fatima centenary plenary indulgence, under the usual conditions, from November 27, 2016 to November 26, 2017, for those who go on pilgrimage to the Sanctuary of Fatima, or visit an image of Our Lady of Fatima that is being publicly venerated on the 13th of each month from May to October 2017. Those who cannot travel can fulfill the conditions in front of a small image of Our Lady of Fatima. To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful, truly penitent and animated with charity, must ritually fulfill the following conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

The important thing during this Fatima centennial year is to realize that we are all engaged in a huge spiritual battle, but it is battle that has in many respects already been won – we just have to keep fighting and eventually victory will come!

Dzień 1) Późnym wieczorem, wylot z lotniska Chicago O'Hare do Tel Aviv.

Dzień 2) Przylot, zapoznanie Menagera grupy, zakwaterowanie w hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 3) Śniadanie, zatrzymamy się w **Betanii** – nawiedzimy sanktuarium Św. Marii, Marty i Łazarza. Następnie przejazd na **pustynię Judy** i **Jerycho** – najstarsze miasto świata, *tu przejazd kolejką linową na Górę Kuszenia* oraz Sycamora – drzewo Zacheusza. Po zwiedzeniu czas spędzimy nad **Morzem Martwym** – największym naturalnym spa, tu czas na relaks i kąpiele. Powrót do hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 4) Śniadanie. **Jerozolima** – sanktuarium: Wniebowstąpienia Jezusa, kościół Pater Noster gdzie Jezus nauczał modlitwy Ojcie Nasz oraz kaplica Dominus Flevit gdzie zapłakał nad losem Jerozolimy. Wejdziemy na **Górę Oliwną** skąd będziemy podziwiać panoramę starej Jerozolimy i słynną złotą kopulę Al-Aksa. Następnie bazylika Agonii Jezusa. Getsemani, grota pojmiania Jezusa, Ogród Oliwny.

Dzień 5) Śniadanie. Wejście bramą Lwów na stare miasto Jerozolimy, *tu przejdziemy „Via Dolorosa” z krzyżem Droga Krzyżową* do bazyliki Grobu Pańskiego na **Kalwarii i Golgoty** – miejsce ukrzyżowania Jezusa. **Góra Syjon** chrześcijański: Bazylika Zaśnięcia NMP, kościół Św. Piotra. In Gallicantu, Wieczernik, grób Króla Dawida. Przejście pod Mur Placzu. Przejazd do hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 6) Śniadanie. **Tyberiadę**, przejazd na **Górę Tabor**, tam wizyta w Bazylice Przemienienia. Później **Galilea** – do sanktuarium na **Górze Błogosławieństw**, gdzie Pan Jezus wygłosił najsłynniejsze ze swoich kazań zawierające osiem błogosławieństw. Nawiedzimy **Tabgha**, ulubione miejsce Jezusa, gdzie nastąpiło cudowne rozmnożenie chleba i ryb. Następnie Kościół Prymatu, gdzie Jezus przekazał klucze do nieba Św. Piotrowi i wybrał 12 apostołów. Kafarnaum – Kefar Nahum, synagoga i dom Św. Piotra. *Przejdziemy przez jezioro Genezaret replikę łodzi Jezusa*, które można nazwać "Jeziołem Jezusa", gdyż wielokrotnie przepływał łodzią przez to jezioro, kroczył po jego wodach (możliwość spożycia ryby Św. Piotra). Yardenit – baptysterium, tradycyjne miejsce chrztu pierwszych chrześcijan nad rzeką Jordan *tu odnowienie sakramentu Chrztu Świętego*. Przejazd do hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 7) Śniadanie, przejazd do **Haify** na **Górę Karmel**, gdzie znajduje się klasztor Karmelitów – Stella Maris. Na zboczach góry zobaczymy przepiękne perskie ogrody Bahai. Przejazd do Cezarei Nadmorskiej. Następnie **Nazaret** – Bazylika Zwiastowania i Kościół Św. Józefa. **Kana Galilejska** – sanktuarium pierwszego cudu Pana Jezusa, tu podczas Mszy Św. *odnowienie ślubów małżeńskich*. Przejazd do hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 8) Śniadanie. Przejazd do **Betleem** gdzie wejdziemy do Bazyliki Narodzenia, Groty Mlecznej, Pole Pasterzy oraz kościół Św. Katarzyny. **Ain Karem** – miejsce nawiedzenia Św. Elżbiety oraz narodzin Św. Jana Chrzciciela. Przejazd do hotelu na kolację i nocleg.

Dzień 9) Śniadanie, przylot do Chicago.

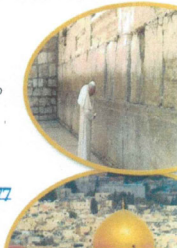
