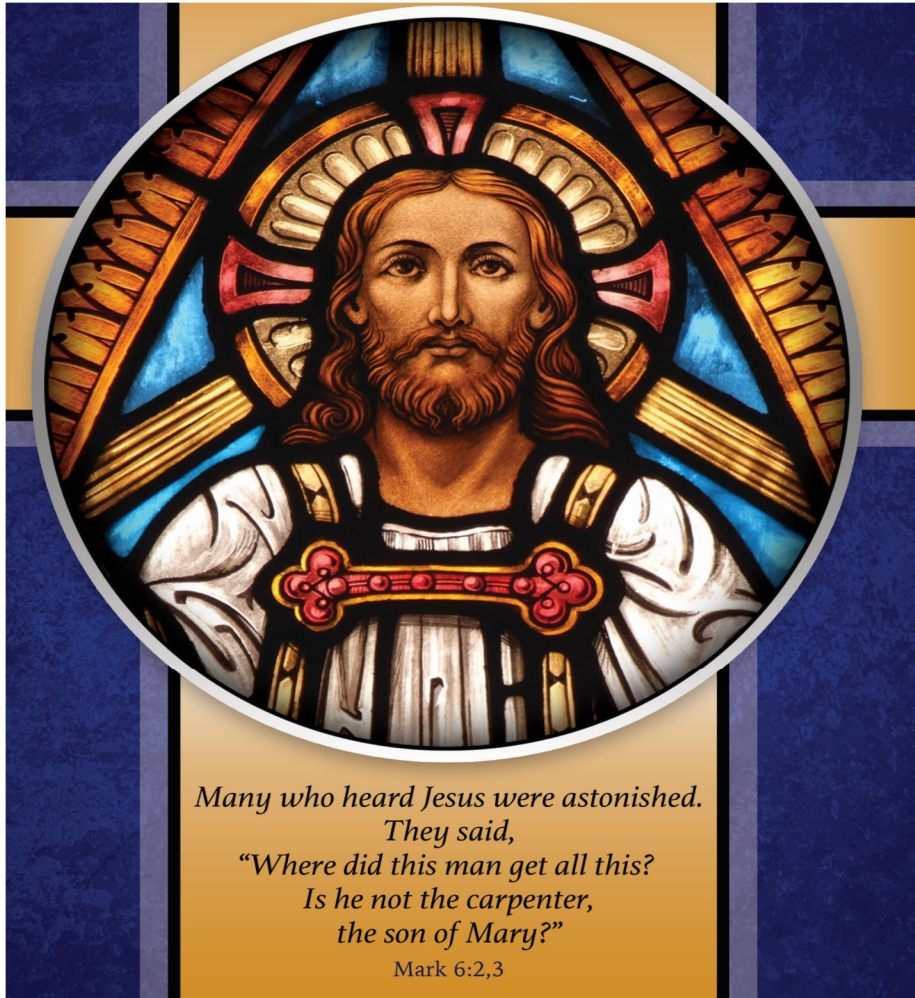

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Last week's Treasure mentioned the "Nuns of the Battlefield," religious sisters from several communities who served as nurses in the Civil War. Florence Nightingale had only instituted female nurses a decade before in the Crimean War, so the idea of women tending to wounded soldiers was extraordinary. The medical and sanitary conditions on the battlefields were appalling, and the sisters were nearly all teachers. Few had any medical training beyond what they had learned as youngsters in the family. Anti-Catholic prejudice was so deeply entrenched in America that sisters could not wear their habits in public. These sisters were the first, and people on both the Union and Confederate sides soon began to marvel at their bravery, efficiency, and respect for Protestant soldiers. More than six hundred sisters from twenty-one communities went to war, serving in wretched conditions. They were tough and single-minded, efficient and fearless.

After the war, sisters could appear in public everywhere in the reunited nation, and often received the praise and gratitude of grateful soldiers and family members on behalf of their sister nurses. An outdoor monument to the "Nuns of the Battlefield" stands in Washington at M Street and Rhode Island Avenue. The inscription reads: "They comforted the dying, nursed the wounded, carried hope to the imprisoned, gave in His name a drink of water to the thirsty."

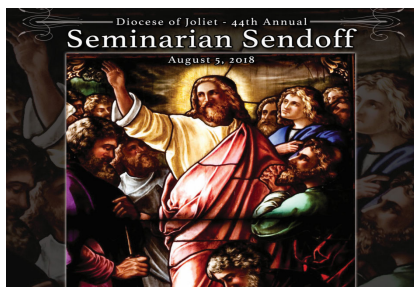

¿QUÉ AGUIJÓN...?

El Espíritu Santo cubre con un velo de silencio un pasaje específico de la Sagrada Escritura. El “aguijón en la carne” en la segunda lectura de hoy es uno de esos lugares silenciosos, porque Pablo —frustrando por siglos a los cristianos— nunca nos dice precisamente cuál es ese aguijón o espina en la carne. Sus amigos en Corinto probablemente sabían a qué se refería, lo cual era suficiente para él. La gente ha especulado que el aguijón era desde una vista mala hasta la rampante lujuria. Pero toda esta especulación pierde el sentido real del mensaje, porque en su debilidad Pablo llega a conocer y vivir la paradoja de la cruz de Cristo: es en nuestra debilidad donde se manifiesta la gran fuerza de Dios. Cuando somos fuertes creemos que la fuerza es nuestra, pero cuando somos débiles, sabemos que cualquier fuerza o poder que tengamos viene solamente de Dios

Each child attending the fair must be accompanied by an adult. Parent/guardian **must** bring the following items in order to receive supplies and services for their children at the fair:

- Identification for all household members:

Adults: state I.D. or driver's license; passport; Mexican consulate I.D.

Children: birth certificate, social security card, medical card, Mexican consulate I.D.

- Proof of Income:

Printouts from: public aid, social security, unemployment, food stamp, link card, check stub, or medical card.

- Verification of Address:

Current utility bill and/or government mail showing Will County address

The Diocese of Joliet Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to help victims/survivors of child sexual abuse by a cleric, employee or volunteer of the Catholic Church. The Victim Assistance Coordinator will report to Bishop Conlon and coordinate efforts of pastoral support and outreach to assist in the healing process.
