**Sacrament of Anointing:** Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

**Holy Communion to the Sick:** When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age, or infirmity, please call the office and arrangements will be made to take Holy Communion to the person.

#### What do our Hospitality Ministries do...

- Our **Greeters** welcome each person with a warm friendly smile, and a sign and/or word of welcome as they open the outside doors of our church.
- Our **Ushers** provide a warm welcome as you enter the interior doors, assist with directions and help each person while they are at Saint Joseph's Church.
- Our **Welcome Kiosk** (which is located at the oak desk in the Narthex) provides an engaging presence where guests can find out **how to become a member of our parish** and where **parishioners can ask questions**, inquire about parish programs and ministries, get Mass cards, request parish contacts, and more.

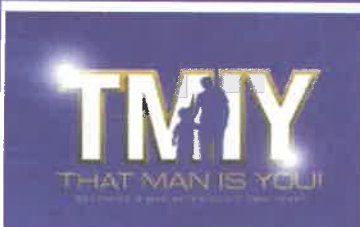
