



### **Parish Campus Maintenance Update**

- <u>PLEC, Church and Parish Office HVAC Preventative Maintenance</u>: Preventative Maintenance Services for 3 campus buildings, to include 15 HVAC units, 3 boilers and 5 natural gas-fired warm air heaters. Contractor completed \$21,684
- PLEC, Church and Parish Office HVAC Corrective Maintenance: Miscellaneous repairs to HVAC units at 3 main campus buildings \$12,495
- Strip & Wax PLEC building Entire building stripped and waxed this year, to include the gym. Volunteers moved all furniture to assist with this effort once again, saving an estimated \$6-7K. Cost of stripping & waxing was \$12,700
- Security Cameras Additional cameras installed and corrective maintenance for existing system \$11,000
- Modernized/integrated HVAC controls in Church building. Integrates HVAC controls across campus onto one system, reducing overall long-term maintenance costs while enhancing security of system \$9,900
