

# **Ministry Highlight: Marriage Mentoring**



We are John and Betti Leonard, coordinators of Saint Joseph Marriage Mentoring Ministry for the past 12 years, although we have been mentors since 2000. We became active in this ministry because we wanted to do something in the parish that we felt was meaningful to us and that we could do together. We believe every marriage should be built upon a strong foundation. This ministry gives engaged couples the opportunity to explore various aspects of marriage with

an experienced couple, trained to facilitate meaningful discussions. One common theme we frequently see is that our couples often are so busy, that their church attendance is sporadic. We share how they can strengthen their own relationship through a renewed one with God, through prayer and participation in Mass, often offering to meet them at Mass.

What do we get out of this ministry? So very much! After 51 years of marriage, we are still discovering things about our own relationship and each other. We feel we are helping couples by sharing our experiences and listening to their concerns. We laugh with them, sometimes we cry with them. We share meals and ideas and so much more. It is rewarding to see our couples in later years as they bring their children to Mass or stop us in the grocery store to tell us how they are doing. We have formed lasting relationships with several of our couples and consider them as friends.

One of these couples, married ten years now, recently said, "I was initially intimidated at the thought of meeting and opening up to a mentor couple, but within minutes I felt completely at ease! Their support, kindness, and Christian example was such a comforting and inspiring experience. To see a Catholic couple who has walked our steps and navigated life's challenges with grace and faith. We have continued to stay in touch with our mentor couple even to this day, to lean on them in our journey as Catholic parents and individuals on a spiritual journey. What a blessing to find this connection in the Marriage Preparation Program!"

Sound interesting? Other mentor couples say: "Becoming a mentor couple is a wonderful experience and has given us the opportunity to grow in our own marriage as we guide engaged couples through marriage preparation. Based on their responses we can make the program relevant and realistic for each couple we work with. The relationships we develop with these young people, as we share our lives with them, have renewed our faith in Christian marriage and given us hope for the future of the Church." Another relates, "Our own marriage has grown as a result of being in this ministry. You don't have to have a perfect marriage, but if you are relatively happy, there is NEED for you in this ministry."

Happily, the number of new marriages in our parish has been increasing, and we need new mentor couples. Mentor training is provided through the diocese. Once trained, we will meet with you to answer questions and get you started. The time commitment varies but involves an initial meeting where the engaged couple answers a computer-based questionnaire. On subsequent meetings their responses serve as the springboard for conversation. Each mentor couple usually works with only one or two engaged couples per year. There are couples out there who need you so they can have the support to start their marriages with a good foundation. They will benefit from their experience with you, but we can guarantee that you will benefit as well!


