



Growing Disciples

Our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) group is growing! Currently 18 individuals are in the process of becoming Catholic, Here's Tyler's story...

My wife brought me to
Saint Joseph parish. She's been a
parishioner since she moved to the area in
2016. I did not attend church growing up but when
I moved to the area in 2019, I would attend Mass
with her on occasion. However, after we got married
in 2020, I wanted to attend Mass with her on a
weekly basis.

During one of our Pre-Cana marriage preparation meetings, our priest gave me the simple advice to attend Mass even if I didn't know what was going on, "I learned it is pretty hard for that relationship [with God] to remain dormant when you visit His house once a week."



or what the scripture was trying to say, and even though I couldn't participate in the Eucharist; just be present at Mass with an open ear and an open mind and try to take something away from Mass that day. That advice is what really kickstarted my faith journey and ultimately what led me to RCIA.

Before attending Mass regularly, I didn't have much of a relationship with God and thought it was possible I was too much of a skeptic to be capable of building one with Him. But, I learned it is pretty hard for that relationship to remain dormant when you visit His house once a week. Attending Mass was the kindling that inherently sparked my relationship with the Holy Spirit. I didn't know it was the Holy Spirit at first but, after learning more about the faith I discovered that is likely who ignited my initial curiosity in possibly joining the Catholic Church and is also the one encouraging me to learn more about it. By participating in RCIA, I hope to continue to nurture my relationship with the Holy Spirit, build a better relationship with the rest of the Holy Trinity, and make new relationships with my fellow parishioners.






