

On this Sunday our Catechumens will head to the Cathedral where the Bishop, on behalf of Christ's universal Church, will agree that those present are ready to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the next major celebration.

But first, we, the local Church, express our support of this step. Each Catechumen's sponsor vouches for them at the sending rite. And we, the priest and the congregation, then agree to "send" the Catechumens to the Bishop.


