CELEBRATING OUR PATRON!

March 19 is the feast day of Saint Joseph, our parish patron saint! This year March 19 is also the 4th Sunday of Lent, and the Universal Church gives both occasions their due by celebrating the Lenten Sunday today and Saint Joseph's feast tomorrow.

How can we honor our patron? Here are a few ideas...

GIVE THANKS FOR OUR HISTORY

- 1860s **Devotions held in Mary Brindle's home**
... while she persistently wrote to the bishops of the Harrisburg Diocese, urging them to send priests to say Mass and provide a permanent place for worship.
- 1879 **1st Mass celebrated in a local home in Mechanicsburg**
... for a humble but devoted congregation of 16 people.
- 1900 **Saint Joseph Chapel established on Arch Street**
... accommodating 125 people.
- 1936 **Saint Joseph has a weekly Mass.**
- 1950 **Saint Joseph becomes a parish**
... after 40 years as a mission of Carlisle.
- 1953 **Saint Joseph Church is dedicated**
... located in the building that is currently our Parish Office. This space was both the church and the school. It could accommodate 500 people for Mass.
- 1977 **Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton "sister parish" is created.**
- 1980 **Broke ground for current church building.**
- 1989 **Second "sister parish" is created - Blessed (now Saint) Katharine Drexel.**


PRAY THE ROSARY OF SAINT JOSEPH


