



Ministry Highlight: Arimatheans

Hi! My name is Diane Freundel. I've been a parishioner of Saint Joseph's for 16 years, a member of the Arimathean Ministry for about 4 years, and the Ministry's coordinator for six months. The Arimathean Ministry is based on Mark's Gospel (Mark 15:42-47) where Mark describes Saint Joseph of Arimathea taking responsibility for the burial of Jesus.

The Arimathean Ministry's mission is to affirm the value and dignity of human life with services and prayers for the dead. Members provide a presence during Funeral and Memorial Masses. We are there to be representatives of Saint Joseph's



Parish family to offer support and prayers for the deceased, their family, and friends. Sometimes there are only a few family members and friends who can attend the Funeral Mass, so the presence of the Arimatheans helps to show that the deceased was a treasured member of our Parish family. We also serve as ushers, Altar servers, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, and livestream operators, as needed, during the Funeral Mass. We get the church ready for the Mass and take care of putting things back in place afterwards. The Arimathean Ministry provides an opportunity to perform a Corporal Work of Mercy and thus helps us to grow as disciples of the Lord Jesus.

On numerous occasions we have received either a note or a verbal expression of thanks from family members and funeral homes for our presence and assistance at funerals. Our presence is noticed and appreciated.


