



Between your work and the kids' school, homework and activities, it can be a bit overwhelming. Of course there's only one thing that gives us true meaning and purpose amid all the running around. Our parish wants to support and encourage our families as they work hard to prioritize their kids' relationship with Christ. This year we added a free dinner on Mondays in between our two religious education sessions. Families can bring their kids to religion class and not have to worry about making dinner. These dinners are part of the "fellowship" dimension of our parish's 5-year plan. Learn more at stjosephmech.org/5-year-plan.



The Tunnel 2 Towers Mobile 9/11 Museum will be coming to Trinity High School on Tuesday, April 25 and Wednesday, April 26. The

museum will be educating students from 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM and will then be open to the public from 4:00 PM - 7:00 PM both days. The museum is gratis, thanks to the generous support of area veteran and civic groups.

9/11 Mobile Museum is a tractor trailer that transforms into a three room museum. The museum will be staffed by 9/11 veteran firemen who will provide firsthand accounts of the events of that day and give tours to the public. Visitors can also hear audio recordings of the first responder radio transmissions and see one of a kind artifacts including pieces of the World Trade Center and items recovered from the rubble after the towers collapsed.




