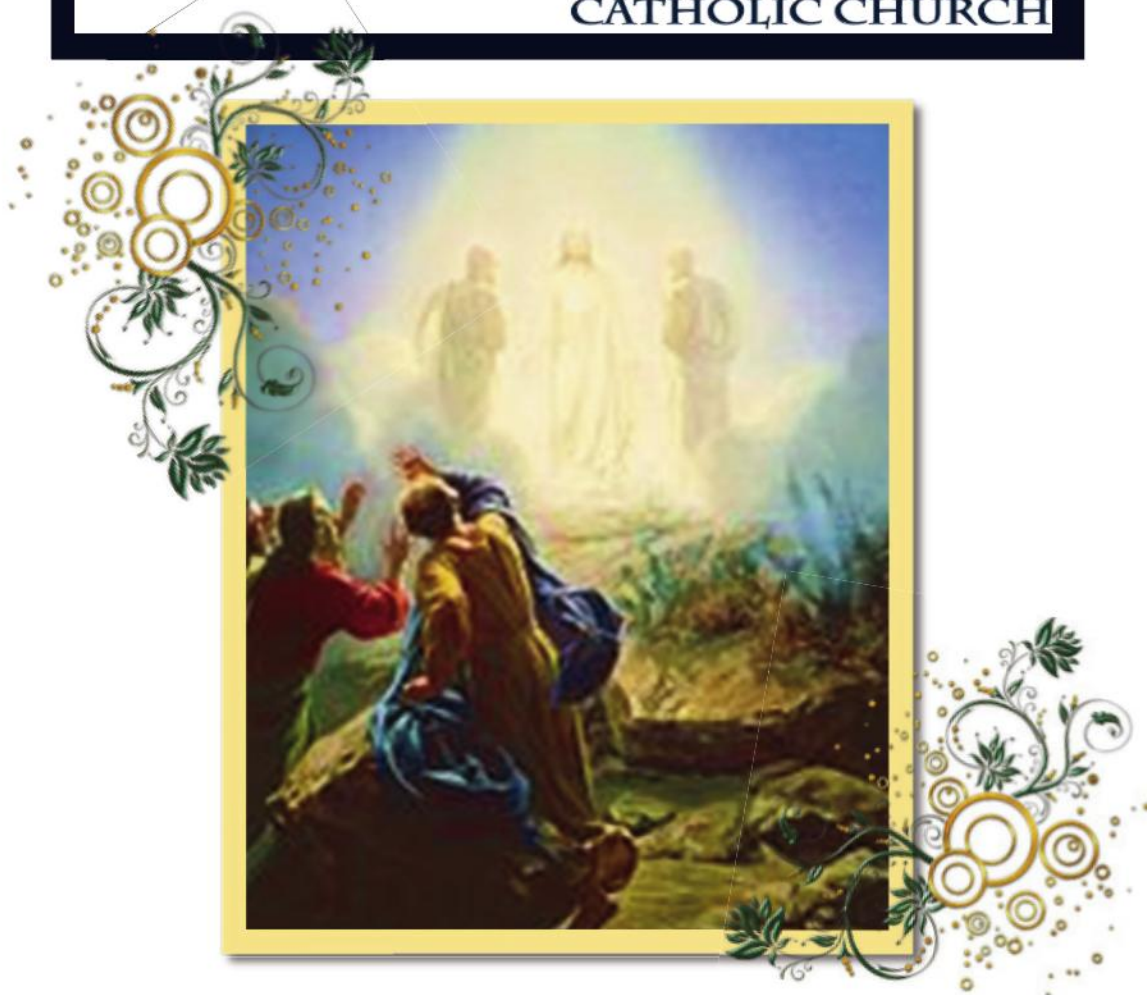

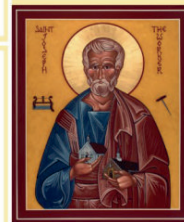

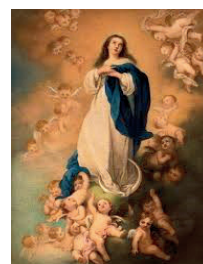

ACCOMPANYING THE POOR AND MARGINALIZED

Every summer, parishes in our diocese are visited for one weekend by a missionary from a Catholic organization or diocese from around the world. We, the parishioners, hear about their essential mission work for the Church, their stories, their challenges, and their successes.

This weekend we are happy to welcome Father Gary F. Wiesmann, Director of Mission Awareness, from the Diocese of Mandeville, Jamaica. The diocese is 30 years old and is one of the largest in its conference. It is also among the poorest in the conference, and the poorest diocese in Jamaica. Despite many challenges, the diocese is committed to their life-affirming work, including:

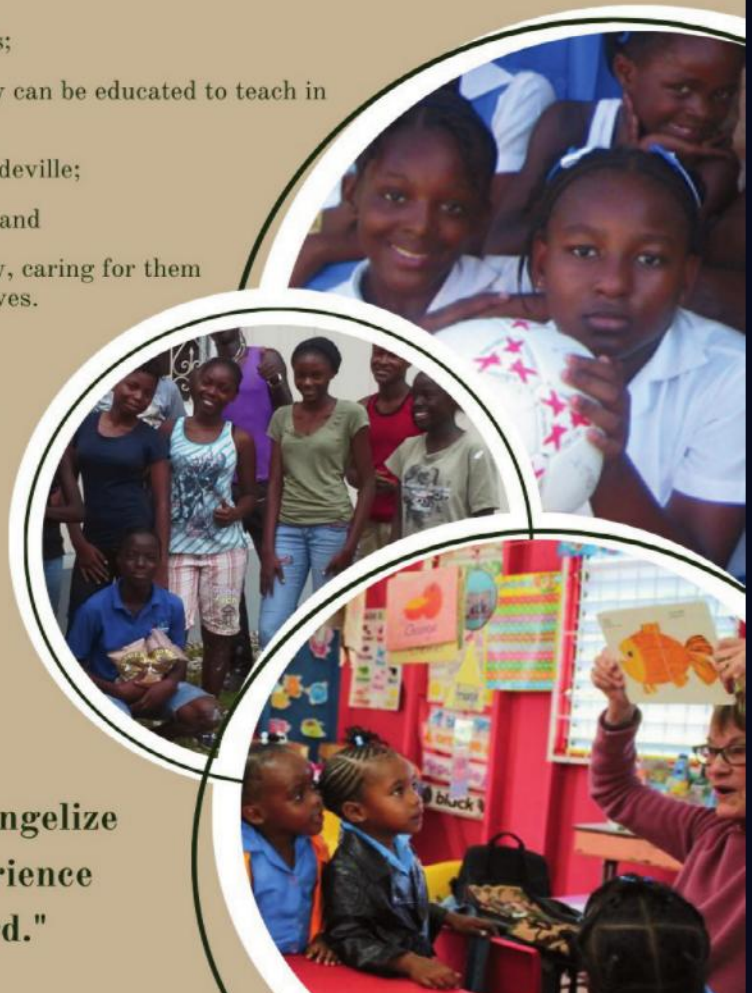
- spreading the Gospel in the Catholic tradition;
- helping people experience the goodness of the Lord and realize their own dignity;
- providing basic food, clothing and housing for poor people throughout the diocese;
- operating health care clinics;
- running a youth residential/work formation center for abused, neglected, and orphaned youth, as well as those youth who need a chance to learn a trade to support themselves and break the cycle of poverty;
- establishing primary/secondary schools;
- providing scholarships to adults so they can be educated to teach in the schools;
- supporting the Catholic College of Mandeville;
- running parish-based youth programs; and
- running a home for the destitute elderly, caring for them as children of God at the end of their lives.

Hearing from Father Wiesmann this weekend increases our awareness of the Church's missionary activity. It also gives us an opportunity to offer our prayers and financial support in order to help Father Wiesmann do God's work in Jamaica.

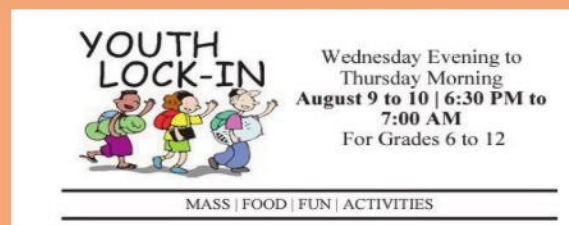

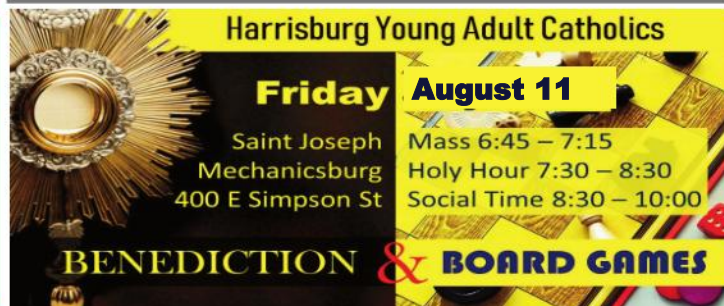
