

ABOUT

A fellowship ministry to build community within the parish. Open to all adult parishioners of Saint Joseph Parish. Each month you will be assigned to a different group of 8 and will have dinner in a host's home. Each couple/participant will provide a portion of the meal. This is a truly enjoyable way to get to know many members of your church community and have a great meal!

This is a casual ministry with it's sole focus to get to know the people with whom we attend church. There is no better way to do that than breaking bread with each other.



You can sign up as a couple or single. A single can also sign up with a friend to be assigned together at each meal. Groups are randomized so you will meet new people each month. By the end of the season you should have seen some people more than once so that relationships begin to build.

Participants that are able and willing volunteer to host meals in their home. This can be done for specific months, at random or every month if they choose. The host will reach out to the assigned group that month to determine the day and time. Most dinners are on the weekend. The host will provide the main dish. The other participants will provide the remainder of the meal such as salad, side and dessert.

Participants do not have to host. You can sign up to enjoy the program without having to host.






