SIGN of **FAITH**

Did you know that Father Rozman is the only signing priest in our diocese? And we are the only parish that offers weekly Masses in sign language? Father learned to sign at the request of Bishop Rhoades and attended Gallaudet University in Washington DC for three summers, taking sign language courses.

As Deaf Catholics learned of the Masses in sign, they began coming first to the Cathedral, where Father was assigned and then to Saint Joseph, when he arrived here 9 years ago.

Our Deaf Community has grown over the years. Members come from Mechanicsburg, East Berlin, Etters, Harrisburg, Hershey and Lancaster. They feel blessed to be able to participate in a Mass that is accessible to them. They also

gather for faith formation each Sunday after Mass

Father Rozman is assisted with signing at Mass by three interpreters, Christine Adzema and Linnet Myers, as well as Ginny Stack who was with Father at the Cathedral. They interpret at 9:45 AM Mass as well as at other liturgical and social parish events. Have you noticed that they always wear clothing that contrasts with their skin tone when interpreting? That's so their hands can be seen more easily! These wonderful volunteers tell us they feel honored to be able to bring the words of the Mass to the deaf community.




After all Masses in the Church this weekend, October 7 & 8, we will offer these prayers for family members who have left the Catholic Church or are unengaged in their commitment to the

MASS INTENTIONS FOR THE UPCOMING YEAR

If you are celebrating a milestone birthday or Anniversary, and would like a Mass offered, we will schedule them on a first come, first serve basis and they will not count towards your 2 Masses per year. All intentions received through our website will be sent to The Missions. The 2024 calendar is now open for requests.



RESPECT LIFE COMMITTEE: A HIGHLIGHT ON

Creating a Culture of Love and Life

Hello fellow parishioners! Last October we celebrated Dobb's overturn of Roe v Wade and looked at the abortion issue through a new lens: the moral vs the legal. Since then, the forces of evil have been hard at work in each state to expand the Culture of Death. We Christians are at war --a war of the culture of death and hate vs a culture of life and love. The US Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has reminded us of the two powerful tools we have, and bids us to use them in this battle. They are the tools Christians have always had. They are Christ's Law of love, and the powerful models of Mary's acceptance of motherhood and Joseph's courageous, steadfast protection and support of her. They are our guides, our inspiration, and the intercessors in this battle.



In answer to Saint John Paul II's call in Evangelium Vitae to establish a culture of life based on the dignity of every human person, the USCCB has devised a program to create what Pope Francis calls "Islands of Mercy" in each parish for moms in need. The program sees each parish becoming a center of welcome and refuge, a place to go for help, when moms see no path except abortion. This is not a new tool. It is the very tool that has been used to combat the evil of the time throughout the ages: Christian love. It is who we are; our identity as Christians. The goal is to educate all parishioners so that everyone knows the resources available to help moms so that the Church is seen as a place of help and love, and abortion becomes unthinkable.

Together with God's help and the intercession of Mary and Joseph, let us create at Saint Joseph's an "Island of Mercy" that shines as a beacon of light in the sea of death and darkness surrounding us. It is up to us! In the words of Saint Teresa of Avila:

"Christ has no body now, but yours, no hands no feet on earth, but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks compassion on the world. Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good. Yours are the hands with which He blesses all the world."

With the prophet Samuel will you answer God's call and say, "Here I am, Lord... I will go Lord, if you guide me... I will hold your mothers in my hands."




