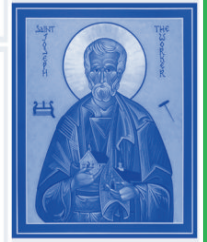

## YOU WERE MADE FOR GREATNESS!

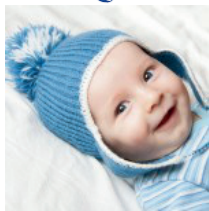


Representatives from The American Red Cross visited SJS to deliver a preparedness program called "The Pillowcase Project". "The Pillowcase Project" is especially geared for students in grade 3 and is funded by a grant from The Disney Corporation. "The Pillowcase Project" teaches students how to stay safe and calm during an emergency and how to be prepared for when emergencies happen. The students learn coping skills to help them deal with the stress of such emergencies. ### Young Adult Advent Day of Reflection and Party

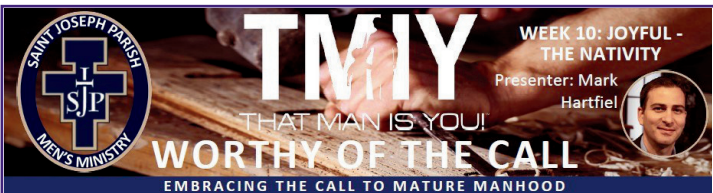
