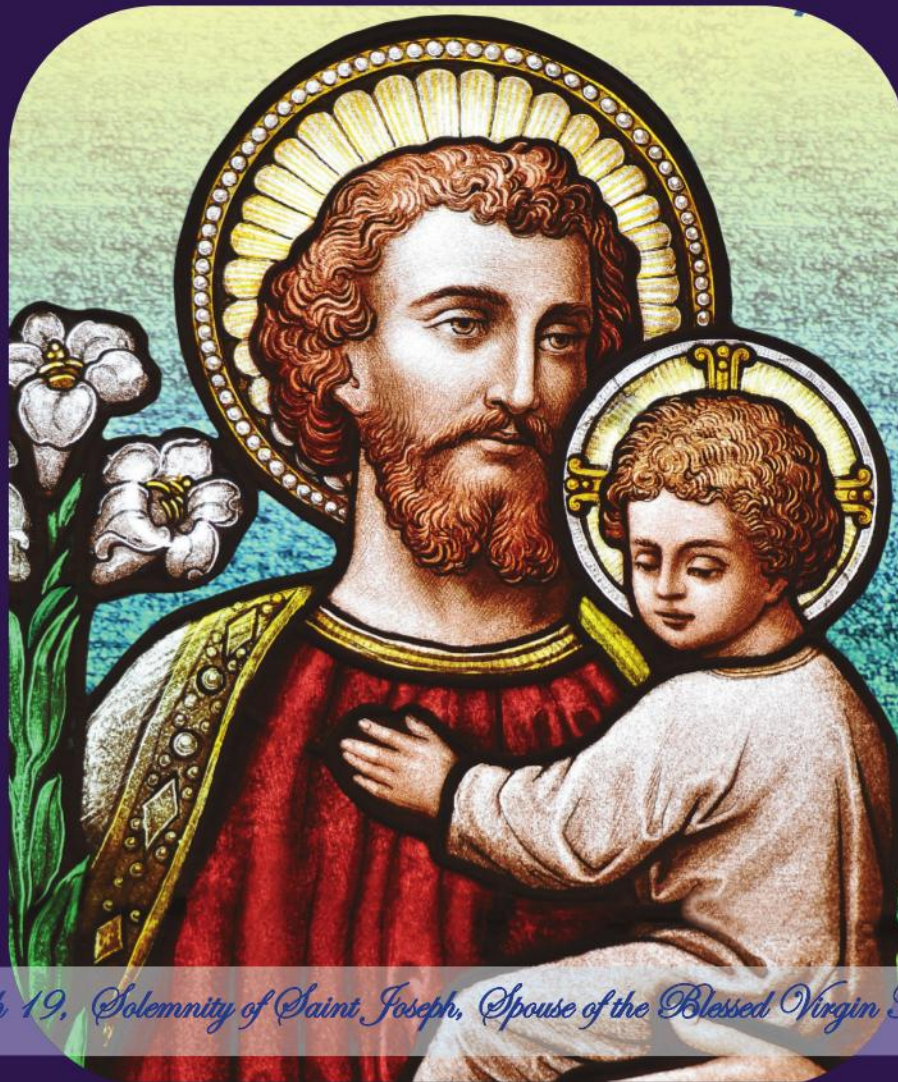

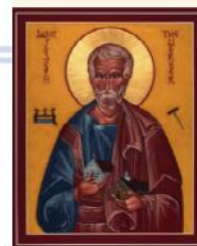

They also tell us that as disciples of Christ, it is our duty to promote human dignity in every aspect of our lives and our world. We are given God's very Spirit to move our hearts with compassion and inspire us to action.

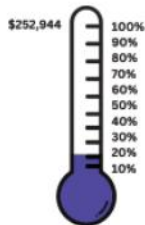
