

## PARISH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY MINUTES

**CALL TO ORDER AND PRAYER:** Marlene Steinour called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Rose Baker provided the reflection, with sharing taking place on the reading from Luke 17:11-19. Intercessory prayers were offered before the closing of the communal prayer.

**WELCOME TO NEW YOUTH AND EVANGELIZATION SENIOR LEADER, DAN MENEZES:** There will be two youth ministry program tracks, one for middle-school students ("Starting Line") and one for high school students ("Aftershock"). These programs will feature fun events, fellowship gatherings, learning about Catholic teaching, and service opportunities. The planned kick-off date is January 7, 2024. Dan is also looking at doing an after-school enrichment program. This program will be introduced at the November 11-12 weekend Masses.

**STRATEGIC PLAN – THE CONTINUOUS PROCESS OF REVIEWING, UPDATING, PLANNING, AND MEASURING:** Lead by Tony Devlin. The SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats) addressed in last month's meeting (under the topics of worship, evangelization, and discipleship) were reviewed, and the SWOT for discipleship were examined and modified where necessary.

**CLERGY UPDATES:** Father Rozman recapped the parish mission, and Eucharistic Revival Committee insights and PAC remarks were shared. Overall, the mission may be considered incredibly successful. Residents of Traditions of America are pilot testing The Rescue Project; the Senior Leadership team will engage in this in Spring 2024 with parish-wide launch in the fall. The Life and Dignity Mass took place on Sunday, October 29, with Bishop Senior attending.

**PARISH MANAGER'S REPORT:** Dave Maceiko offered an overview of improvements and changes planned and active around the parish campus, shared the results of Parish Manager Meeting and Diocese Building and Safety Meeting, and provided an update on the Diocesan Annual Campaign commitments.

**PAC CHAIR UPDATES:** Marlene Steinour provided updates regarding PAC communications, PAC terms, the Mass guidebook, PAC by-laws, and parish survey.

The meeting ended at 12:01 with a prayer led by Rose Baker.

The next meeting is Saturday, December 2, at 9 AM, with a gathering prior.
