Do we truly UNDERSTAND THE MASS or are we just going through the motions?

Monthly Pre-Mass Teaching Elements: By now, everyone has noticed that we have a short welcome at the beginning of each weekend Mass. We provide information to help newcomers feel at home, and we invite everyone to greet those they'll be praying with and for during the liturgy. But you may not have noticed that once a month, we add a "teaching element" to these pre-Mass announcements.

- In June we heard how the pause following the initial "let us pray" at Mass is intended for us to recollect and offer our personal intentions.
- In July we learned about the history and significance of genuflecting.
- In August and September we focused on the entrance procession and the dismissal.

This is all the result of a goal in our parish's 5-Year Plan to offer teaching elements on the Mass. Rather than a class that may be attended by 25 people, we decided to offer small, timely bits of information to the 1200+ people who attend Mass on the weekends. An added benefit of this approach is that the information is offered just in time to see it in action. What do you think? We'd love to hear your opinions!
