# Steps for making a good confession

- Examine your conscience by using this brochure and reflecting on your sins and life choices.
- After examining your conscience, enter the confessional, be seated or kneel and say, "bless me, Father, for I have sinned."
- Then tell the priest how long it has been since your last confession. If it is your first time, then you say, "this is my first confession."
- Begin confessing the sins that you are sorry for and from which you wish forgiveness.
- When you have finished your confession the priest will offer some words of wisdom. Listen to him carefully. He will then give you a penance to perform and offer you absolution.
- You will then recite the "Act of Contrition."
