In this Sunday's Gospel, as we hear the story of the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we also come to know that our daily reaching out to our neighbor is our daily walk with the risen Christ; we recognize him in others.

#### LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

To receive a letter of recommendation for a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation you must be registered members of the parish (<u>for at least 6 months</u>); who regularly attend Mass and receive the sacraments. Regular use of envelopes indicates attendance at Mass. Sponsors are to be Baptized, Confirmed, and if married, have done so in conformity with the laws of the Church. Adult children (18 and over) should be registered on their own. Out-of-town college students should receive a letter from their campus minister. People in the military should receive a letter from their chaplain.

Young adults who were confirmed recently and also are working, even part time, should assume their own identity in the parish by registering in their own name.

#### EDUCATIONAL CORNER

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING IN THE CATECHISM

The Catechism of the Catholic Church has a comprehensive section on the Sacrament of Anointing (nn.1499-1523). After reviewing the biblical and historical development of the sacrament, the Catechism proceeds to outline the purpose, the ritual and the effects of the sacrament.

#### Benefits of the Sacrament

As the Catechism states, the sacrament gives strength to the dying and to "anyone of the faithful (who) begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age" (n. 1514). Certainly, the sacrament may be given to those about to undergo serious surgery and may be repeated if the sick person recovers and then relapses. The elderly, too, may receive the sacrament more than once as "frailty becomes more pronounced" (n.1515). The primary benefits include healing and recovery, not a last-minute preparation for death.

#### Who administers the sacrament?

Only bishops and priests may administer the Sacrament of Anointing? Pastors must instruct the faithful on the benefits of the sacrament and encourage them to call for a priest when they or their loved ones are seriously ill or wounded (n. 1516). The recipient need not be bedridden. The sacrament may be given in any fitting place, including home, hospital or other care facility.
