CONFIRMATION NEWS

The Diocese recommends that parishes that had scheduled Confirmation on a calendar during the first half of the year in 2020 should look to reschedule them for a date when it is deemed safe to gather as a congregation. It may be preferable that these Confirmations would take place when school is back in season in the Fall. The Bishop may grant delegation to the Pastor of the Parish to Officiate at the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for the qualified Candidates of his Parish once it is possible to safely do so.

The Anointing During Mass

Since Vatican II, the Church has also provided for celebration of the Sacrament of Anointing during Mass. The faithful who are ambulatory or in wheelchairs but suffering with chronic illness or aging gather in church, along with their loved ones or caregivers. Generally they sit at the ends of the aisles so that the priest can easily anoint them, and those nearby can place hands on them during the anointing. There are special prayers for the Mass as well as Scripture readings and a special Preface. People who have participated in these Masses have found them to be uplifting and comforting.
