MIDDLE STATES TEAM VISIT

We will welcome the Middle States Team to IHM on Tuesday afternoon, April 1. The visit will conclude on Friday, April 4, 2025. Our faculty and staff have been working extremely hard over the last 18 months to prepare for this re-accredidation visit.

On Tuesday, April 1, the Middle States Team is requiring all teachers/staff to be present for a meet and greet, school tour and a reception. **Therefore, there will be no PM Cares on Tuesday, April 1.**

On Wednesday, April 2, the Middle States Team will be throughout the building observing classes, running panel meetings, and also observing Cares.

On Thursday, April 3, the Middle States Committee will be observing classes and meeting with 20 IHM Students and 7 IHM Families for a student and parent panel. Thank you to all of the students and families who were nominated or volunteered to be a part of these panels. We have no doubt that the students and families taking part in these sessions will represent IHM extremely well!

On Friday, April 4, the Middle States Team will present their findings of the visit. Therefore, all teachers and staff are required to be present for the reading of this report. We will have a half-day dismissal on Friday, April 4 to accommodate this requirement. There will be no PM Cares.

Once the Middle States team leaves on Friday, April 4, we will receive a oral report of their findings. Middle States will let us know if we have been formally accrediated sometime in Fall 2025. We will also publish our Middle States Self-Study at the conclusion of the Middle States Team Visit.


