

He will be speaking at all Masses the weekend of September 30/October 1 as well as presiding at the 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. John Capistran on Monday and Tuesday.

Fulton Sheen: Reasons 3 and 4

Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen writes: Why make a Holy Hour? Here are reasons 3 and 4:

- 3. Because Our Lord asked for it. "Had you no strength, then, to watch with me even for an hour?" (Matt. 26:40) The word was addressed to Peter, but he is referred to as Simon. It is our Simon-nature, which needs the hour. If the hour seems hard, it is because ... the spirit is willing enough, but the flesh is weak. (Mark 14:39)
- 4. Because the Holy Hour keeps a balance between the spiritual and the practical... The golden mean is in the words of St. Thomas: "action following rest," Martha walking with Mary. The Holy Hour unites the contemplative to the active life of the person.

Thanks to the hour with Our Lord, our meditations and resolutions pass from the conscious to the subconscious and then become motives of action. A new spirit begins to pervade our work. The change is effected by Our Lord, Who fills our heart and works through our hands. A person can give only what he possesses. To give Christ to others, one must possess Him.

### A FEW NOTES ABOUT OUR GIFT CARD PROGRAM:

Purchase gift cards from the parish at face value and redeem the cards at the vendor for the full value of the card. Resurrection Parish receives rebates from each vendor which are earnings for the Parish - PAID BY THE VENDOR, NOT YOU OR ME.

Currently, the Parish receives approximately \$40,000 from 300 families purchasing gift cards. With increased participation, ANNUAL EARNINGS to the Parish could conservatively be \$250,000, and optimistically be \$1 million. **PAID BY THE VENDOR, NOT YOU OR ME**.

# How do I purchase gift cards?

- 1. Online through Raise Right, 24/7/365. Register at <a href="www.raiseright.com">www.raiseright.com</a> with an assigned enrollment code (Please contact Parish or School office for this). There are 750 vendors and many are e-cards. Pay with a registered checking account at a fee of ONLY \$0.29 per transaction, or credit card with a fee of 2.6% per transaction.
- 2. Purchase physical gift cards in-person, 7 days/week. We have 20 local vendors at both parish offices during business hours and before/after weekend Masses. Pay by check or cash with **NO** fee, or credit card with a fee of 3.6%.
