Parish Office Hours: During this time of transition (with Covid and resulting position changes), the Marysburg and Nativity Parish Office has had to flex. This week of August 29, the Parish Office will be closed on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, but it will be open on Thursday and Friday, September 2 and 3.

In college, dating, I spent a lot of time studying marriage. Even after my first conversion, I thought a lot about dating and relationships. I remember discovering that the teachings of Christ and the Church were practical and authentic to real-life experience.

Before I converted to Catholicism, I was in a marriage and family class taught by a non-Christian agnostic/ atheist professor who gave us statistics about marriage and divorce. It showed me that saving yourself for marriage, not living with someone before marriage, sharing faith in marriage, etc., increased the odds of a marriage lasting significantly. I found other statistics very compelling, and it showed a kind of validation for my faith.

Later on, I discovered the beautiful teachings and philosophy of now St. John Paul II in his work, "Love and Responsibility." It was challenging to go through as it was very philosophical and used a language I was not as familiar with reading. I did get a great deal of wisdom out of the book. I won't go through all of it, but I will highlight some of its essential teachings. The reason I want to do so is this weekend's teaching on marriage and its in-dissolvability. There can be so much pain and even sadness, either from divorce, whether having gone through one as a spouse or having split parents. I pray a lot for people in marriage, and I mention it as an intention in so many of my Masses because I know there are many hurts everywhere.

Jesus designed marriage. The critical phrase as I see it this weekend's Gospel is that after the Pharisees say Moses allowed for writing a bill of divorce, Jesus responds that it was because of the hardness of hearts that Moses allowed for it. Pride is at the heart of the marriage breakdown. I want things my way, I need you to live up to my standards, and I'm the center of the world. The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines pride as "inordinate self-esteem or self-love, which seeks attention and honor and sets oneself in competition with God (#1866). If you compete with God, you can then compete with your spouse. It's not first about communication, as many in culture might say, but first, I don't communicate or listen because I'm prideful. Humility is the opposite of pride. While pride doesn't need God or others, humility recognizes our limits and sees ourselves as we indeed are: that God is our creator, sustainer, and redeemer. Faith enables us to have humility because humility and faith coincide. Without faith, we don't see our brokenness and need for redemption. Without faith to rely on God, it is harder to rely on another, or to be vulnerable with one another, and to share our hearts deeply.

I realize I cannot solve all the world's problems, and now having written what I have, I realize how extensive topic is, beyond the justice I can do it here. However, I can give you a book suggestion, Made This Way, by Leila Miller and Trent Horn. The book is an excellent refresher on the challenging but beautiful moral teachings of the Church and how to share them with children of varying age groups. Also, a great gift is watching two excellent talks by Deacon James Keating on YouTube: Love and Responsibility - 3. Spiritual Intimacy, as well as, The Choice to Have God in Our Marriages - Spousal Prayer.
