

We pray for peace these days for the conflict in Ukraine. It's hard to know what to think about the aggression of Russia. What we are concerned about is the destruction of life and the brutality that war means. I can be fairly confident that it is an unjustified war, especially considering our Catholic tradition of St. Thomas's "Just War" theory (possibly a topic for a future article). We pray for a cease-fire and hopefully an end to armed conflict. I haven't been following as closely and its hard because things change so rapidly but I have been praying.

Lent is upon us! As I write this bulletin article it is Ash Wednesday and the reading at Mass proclaims: "Rend your hearts, not your garments!" This refers to the ancient Jewish practice of tearing one's own clothes as a sign of repentance or hearing blasphemy. If you saw "the Passion of the Christ" the Jewish leaders did this action when Jesus declared "you will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds" a reference to his Divinity. "Blasphemy" they cried as they tore their shirts because Jesus had equated himself with God. For Jews and now Muslims God is so other that he could not be part of his creation, so it was the worst crime. Rend your hearts, is a call to serious conversion, serious tearing of one's heart for the seriousness of sin. We have sinned and we need to take it seriously.

I think what happens so often is that we think only of the sins of commission rather than the sins of omission which are no less serious. St. Theresa of Avila said once that "it's not so much what people do in mortal sin that surprises her but the things that they don't do." Just a week or two ago, we had that reading of the Sermon on the Mount from Luke where Jesus gives the golden rule,

"do unto others as you would have them do unto you."
If we really think about that statement we would want
so much done for us but are we willing to go outside of
ourselves to love and do those things for others. It is
not, 'don't do' like so many other religious versions, but a
call to love. . It's a positive law of love, even infinite love.
Love that is in the Trinity! Impossible you say? Well, you
are right. On your own, you cannot do this, "Apart from
ME you can do nothing." In fact, often enough we do evil.

War, strife, and chaos are always a breath away from sinful man. We've seen strife with the riots in our country, and now the conflict in Ukraine, but only when Christ comes again will that change. For now, it's an urgent call to us to be holy, to follow Christ and for that, we have the urgency of Lent! Lent has been described in many ways but I think it is a great readjustment, a call to the urgency of taking our faith seriously. I think sometimes life can let us get comfortable, but Lent is a time to jolt us out of that comfort to the urgent need of our world for saints to shape it. For you and me, lets realize our need for God and His grace, let go of our malaise, the stupor that can cling to us. Let us pray for each other this Lent that it is a transformative one!
