### PARTICIPATION IN MASS IN UNION WITH THE SACRED PASSION OF CHRIST.

St. Francis de Sales developed a method for reflecting on parts of the Holy Mass as they coincide with the Sacred Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ. In a devotional daily missal authorized by John Cardinal Farley, Archbishop of New York in 1914, each element of the Holy Mass is joined with an element of the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ. These moments in the Passion of our Lord help us to reflect upon the sacrifice of our Blessed Lord during Holy Mass.
