## Celebrating with Brother André's Cafe



**Kurt Kondrich** is a retired police officer and disability advocate for Down Syndrome Awareness. Kurt's daughter Cloe was born in 2003 with a diagnosis of Down syndrome. After her birth, he became an advocate for Down Syndrome awareness. He has received several awards for his advocacy, including the PA Pro-Life Federation Leadership Award and St Anthony Award from the Diocese of Pittsburgh and has spoken at the United Nations in 2017 and 2018 to protect those diagnosed prenatally with Down syndrome. His efforts lead to the PA legislature passing the Down syndrome Prenatal Education Act ("Cloe's Law") in July 2014.

Brother André's Cafe is a shop named after the patron saint of caregivers, Brother André Besette. Brother André faced hardships finding employment because of his sickness and frailty, but he later went on to perform miracles.

Brother Andre's Cafe is a coffee shop staffed by adults with Intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). It is part of Move a Mountain Missions (MMM).
