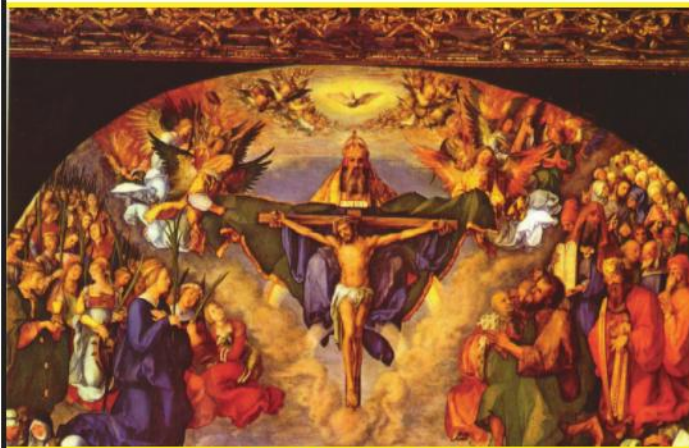

Scriptural Context Mark's Gospel

Despite appearing second, Mark's gospel is now recognized as being the first written of those that appear in the Bible. The shortest of the four gospels, it begins with Jesus' entry into public life and, in its original form, ends with the discovery of the empty tomb. It is sometimes called a gospel 'in a hurry' as the movement between events is almost abrupt. The gospel writer identifies almost immediately that Jesus is God's 'beloved Son' and then spends the rest of the gospel describing the gradual revelation of this fact and the disciples' growing awareness.

Q Who are the catechumens?

A Catechumens are unbaptized persons (adult or children of catechetical age) who have celebrated the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. Once they have been received into the Order of Catechumens, they have an official status in the Catholic Church. Like a mother, the Church cares for catechumens, nourishing them with the celebration of the Word in the Sunday liturgy and other celebrations of the Word, as well as other rites such as anointing with the Oil of Catechumens, blessings, and minor exorcisms. The Church has designated appropriate rites of marriage and burial for catechumens. The names of all who have celebrated the Rite of Acceptance are recorded in a special registry, and a person celebrates the Rite of Acceptance only once.

Stewardship Reflections

How often do we turn to Jesus in prayer with a very specific request? "Please heal my mom." "Please help me get this job." "Please ease my suffering." We can look at the request of James and John in today's gospel and recognize the self-centered nature of their question. Jesus, rather than rebuking them, simply invites them into his suffering, and tells them that if they want honor they must become servants of all. Being fully alive as missionary disciples means that we, too, are willing to put our self-centered requests to the side. Instead, we can ask God to help us serve others (and HIM!) to the best of our ability. Then, our prayers might sound more like this: "Please give me the mind and heart to care for my mother through her death." "Please give this job to the person who needs it the most." "Please help me use this suffering to grow in love for you and others." Prayer is one of the pillars of stewardship, and is most certainly a way we can serve God and others!
