Halloween, All Saints Day, All Soul's Day "Dia de los Muertos"

Starting October 31st, we begin the Triduum of the Eve of All Hallows, All Saint's Day and All Souls' Day. Many cultures throughout the world remember those who have died. Catholics, Episcopalians and Orthodox may light candles or have a Mass said for their loved ones. Eastern religions burn incense before pictures of their deceased relatives. People in many countries use this day to visit the graves of their loved ones and leave flowers or candles. These celebrations and feasts have one thing in common: an awareness that death is immanent and that humans have an innate sense there is an afterlife. We all look forward to the day we will be reunited with God and our loved ones.

Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) is celebrated in many parts of the United States, particularly where there are large Latin American communities. It draws its roots from the Aztecs who over 3000 years ago celebrated this festival with parades, death masks, skulls, food and drink in honor of those who had died. Today, Day of the Dead in Mexico and the United States incorporates some of the ancient Aztec themes and Roman Catholic traditions including parades, altars where photos of loved ones and ofrendas (offerings of food) are brought and a Book of Remembrance for enrolling names of loved ones who have died.

All Souls' Day was first instituted at the monastery in Cluny, France in 993 and quickly spread throughout the Christian world. It was Saint Odilo, the abbot of Cluny, who proposed that the day after All Saints' Day (November 1) be set aside to honor the departed, particularly those whose souls were still in purgatory. The Eve of All Hallows simply refers to the evening before All Saints. In the Roman Catholic tradition, major feasts always have an anticipatory vigil the night before (e.g. Christmas Eve, the Easter Vigil). So too with the Eve of All Hallows, we are beginning our prayer and remembrance of those who have died (All Saints and All Souls) tonight at sunset. You can see how the secular celebration of Halloween has taken pieces of these three sacred days and Dia de los Muertos and commercialized it; however, left out the religious and spiritual dimensions.

So, in the true Spirit of these sacred three days, we remember that we have finite bodies, but an immortal soul destined to be with God and All the Saints. We remember all of the Saints, those saints who have been formally canonized by the Church and the little ones like our loved ones who inspired us to live good lives. We lift all of them up to God and ask that we may join Him with this Communion of Saints one day, when "all will be One through Christ."

Let us also remember that **"All Saints Day", Thursday, November 1st, is a Holy Day of Obligation.** Our Mass times are **Wednesday Vigil at 6 pm and Thursday 8am, 12:10 pm and bilingual Mass at 6 pm.**

Scriptural Context Mark's Gospel

Despite appearing second, Mark's gospel is now recognized as being the first written of those that appear in the Bible. The shortest of the four gospels, it begins with Jesus' entry into public life and, in its original form, ends with the discovery of the empty tomb. It is sometimes called a gospel 'in a hurry' as the movement between events is almost abrupt. The gospel writer identifies almost immediately that Jesus is God's 'beloved Son' and then spends the rest of the gospel describing the gradual revelation of this fact and the disciples' growing awareness.

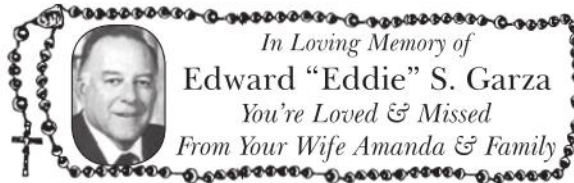
