At our November meeting, the CDS Interim Pastoral Council engaged in planning for parish ministry and evangelization in 2021. Anticipating the upcoming results of our Resource Planning Advisory Committee, we began by formulating our values which are intended to guide our actions next year. Looking at a variety of areas, we settled on the following values:

#### **Eucharist**

- The Sunday Eucharist is celebrated with full and active participation by the parish community
- Our parish makes sufficient effort to involve youth and young adults (other than altar servers) in Eucharistic celebrations

#### **Catechesis**

- Impactful adult faith formation opportunities are available in our parish
- Faith formation programs support and equip parents as the primary educators of their children

#### Promotion of a faith that is bold, courageous, and effective

- Sufficient opportunities are provided for parishioners to serve those in need
- Our parish makes sufficient efforts to meet the needs of people who may feel excluded from parish life at some point (e.g., divorced people, single parents, the elderly)

#### **Evangelization**


Sufficient efforts are made to sustain the faith of practicing members of our parish

#### Stewardship

- We make regular efforts to discover parishioners' talents and invite their use in parish service
- Our parish adequately imitates Christ through social action and community outreach

A Reminder that Private Prayer is held alternately in both Monroeville and Penn Hills.






