From the Moderator

Next week, Fr Rick will begin his retirement. On behalf of the clergy, staff, and parishioners of Christ the Divine Shepherd Parish, I'd like to thank him for his priestly ministry in the diocese over the past 25 years! In a particular way, I'd like to extend our gratitude to him for the pastoral ministry he's exercised over the past three years, as our parish chaplain to UPMC East and Forbes hospitals!

As you may recall, the diocese has informed us that there is no priest available to be assigned to take Fr Rick's role at CDS. This year, there will probably be one or two dozen priests in the Pittsburgh Diocese who will retire. This weekend, Bishop Zubik will ordain *only one man* to the priesthood for the Diocese of Pittsburgh. That's a stunning ratio of retirements to ordinations! For many years, the notion of a "vocation crisis" has been part of the discussion in the Catholic environment – not only in Monroeville or our diocese, but in many areas of our country (and even the Western world!). You can get a feel for the scope of the problem by checking out the statistics collected by the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate, found at cara.georgetown.edu/frequently-requested-church-statistics/

What impact does a 'vocations crisis' have on us, at the parish level? We will have the ability to celebrate fewer Masses in the parish (one per day for weekdays, and six on weekends). Our ability to be present at a moment's notice in an emergency will diminish (for instance, if you or a loved one wishes to be anointed in the hospital or at home in hospice care).




JESUS' EXAMPLE OF HELPING OTHERS

In today's second reading Paul offers a wonderful argument to his converts at Corinth for seeking to help those in need. He is dealing with a practical problem, arranging a collection for the poor of the church of Jerusalem; but as he often does, he develops an important teaching about Jesus to make his point.

After asking that they show their faith by generous gifts, he reminds them of the "gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, for your sake he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich" (2 Corinthians 8:9). In the Incarnation our Lord assumed our human nature, certainly becoming poor for one who is God. The ultimate gracious act of this poverty was going to the cross with all its terrible sufferings. By this act of poverty we definitely become rich. Now our sins can be forgiven; we can share in the very life of God through the sacraments; we can attain eternal salvation!

The long-term solution to this 'vocations crisis' is the development of a culture that celebrates and encourages priestly vocations. You can help build this culture through your personal prayers and your witness to the ways you value the priesthood. As I mentioned at Masses last weekend, Divine Mercy Academy is our Catholic school for Monroeville, Penn Hills, and Pitcairn. 



One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing him he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him, and a large crowd followed him and pressed upon him. While he was still speaking, people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

Profession of Faith

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

The altar is prepared, the gifts are received. Several brief rites follow with accompanying prayers, some prayed silently by the priest and deacon and others said aloud. We call this part of the Mass the "preparation." What kind of preparation is happening? First, the presider holds up the paten or bowl containing the hosts, and says words that Jesus must have said many times, since they derive from ancient Jewish meal prayers: "Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation!" We have brought forward our gifts, our offering to God, and now we acknowledge that they are not really ours—the gifts that we give are God's gift to us. It is "through your goodness" that we have gifts to offer. It is significant that we offer not wheat and grapes, but bread and wine; "fruit of the earth and work of human hands." Bread and wine are both God's work, and ours. These preparatory rites also prepare us for what we are about to do in the Eucharist, a mystery in which divine and human meet; a holy collaboration in which our action is caught up into God's divine plan.
