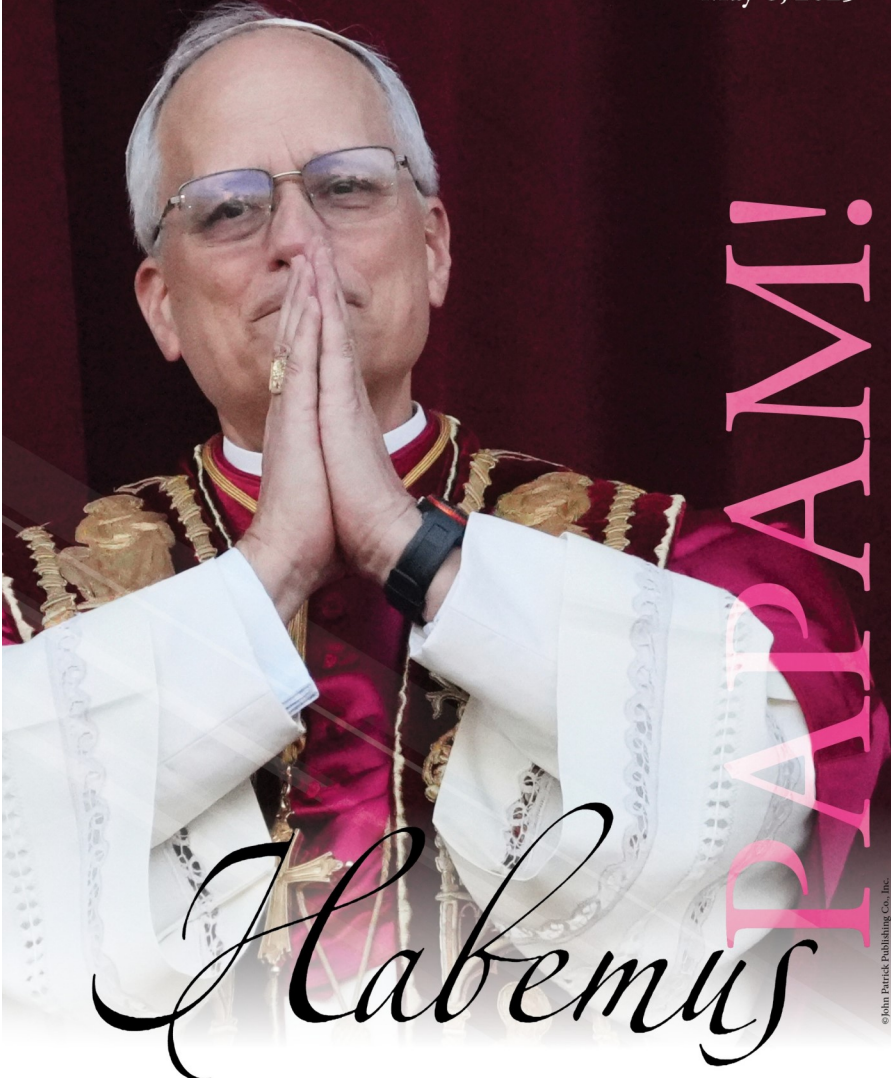

Mrs. Nikole Laubham grew up in Penn Hills and earned a degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from the University of Pittsburgh before attending Seton Hill University to obtain her elementary teaching certification. She began her teaching career in 1995 at North American Martyrs School as a second grade teacher, later moving to first grade and ultimately finding her passion in third grade. In her final two years at NAM, she was asked to serve as Lead Administrator while continuing to teach.

After the merger that formed Divine Mercy Academy, she returned to the classroom full time as a third grade teacher. When the DMA principal left in April 2022, she was asked to step in to finish out the school year. That summer, she was offered the full-time principal position, prompting her to return to school to pursue a master's degree in Educational Leadership at Carlow University. While completing her graduate studies, she served as interim principal for two years and officially became principal in May 2024. Upon graduating, she was honored with Carlow University's Outstanding Service Award.

Over the course of her career, she has dedicated herself fully to Catholic education, spending thirty years serving in Catholic schools—a vocation she holds close to her heart. In her final year of classroom teaching, she was recognized with the prestigious Golden Apple Award for excellence in teaching. She truly believes there is nowhere else she'd rather be than working alongside the students, families, teachers, and staff of Divine Mercy Academy.

She has been married for over thirty years and is the proud mother of three adult children—two working in the medical field and one currently in college studying fashion design. In the little spare time that she has, Mrs. Laubham enjoys listening to audiobooks, drawing, journaling, traveling, and spending time with her family. She is deeply grateful for the support of her family throughout her journey in Catholic education.

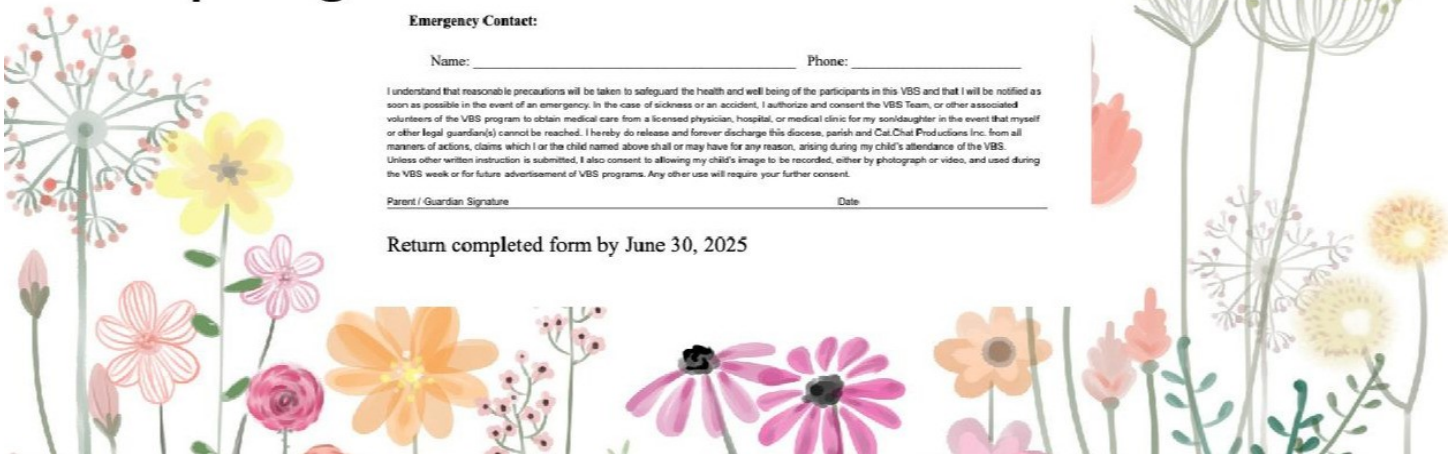
