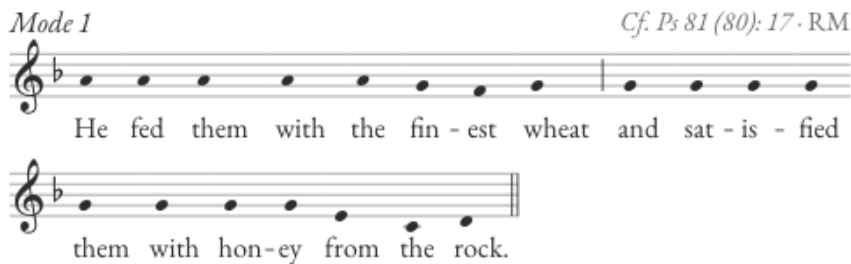

Prayer Before Mass

O most loving Father, grant me your beloved Son. While on this earthly pilgrimage, I receive Him under the veil of this sacrament; so may I come at last to see Him face to face for all eternity. For He lives and reigns with You forever and ever. Amen.

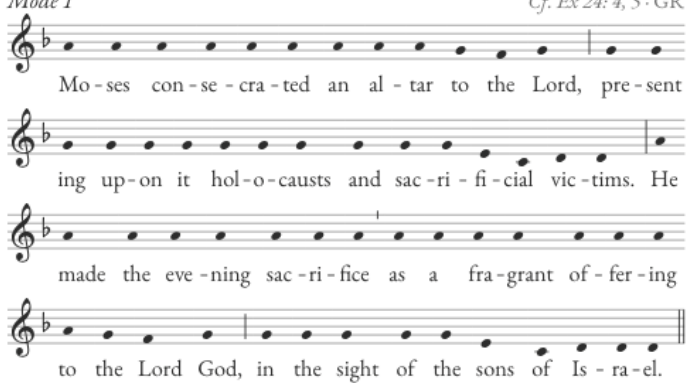

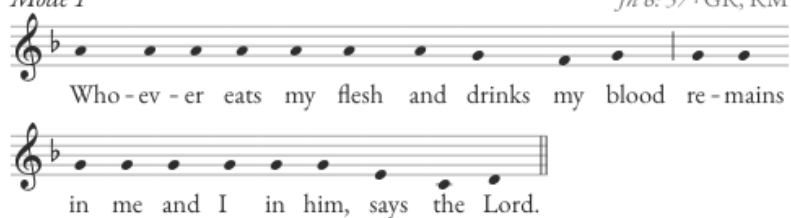

Thanksgiving Prayer after Mass

And I pray that you will lead me, a sinner, to the magnificent banquet where you, with your Son and the Holy Spirit, are for all your saints the true light, total fulfillment, everlasting joy, gladness without end, exquisite delight, and most perfect happiness.

Grant this through Christ our Lord. Amen.



Welcome Father William Wuenschel

Big news for our parish! We knew some time ago that Father Gruber would be heading to Kansas on July 1, and prayed that the Lord (and the Bishop) would send us a priest, not knowing for sure if this would be the case. Our prayers have been answered! Bishop Zubik is sending us Father William (Will) Wuenschel! He is 10 years ordained and comes from Mount Oliver, a borough tucked inside the borders of the City of Pittsburgh (not far from Carrick, where I am from). I have known him for a long time and count him a friend. I look forward to you meeting him and welcoming him to our parish! He most recently served at Saint Aidan Parish in Wexford.

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi

We celebrate the Holy Eucharist every day, and every Sunday together as a Church. Today we celebrate the Eucharist as such, marveling at the fact that we receive Jesus, His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, every time we celebrate Holy Mass.

The Holy Eucharist is awesome, in the fullest sense of the word!

That said, it is sometimes difficult to really prepare for and thank our Lord for the gift of Himself He gives us each Mass. To this end, we have started including a preparation prayer and a thanksgiving for Holy Communion prayer in the bulletin. Most Sundays these will be where they are this week, with the hymn numbers. If we need more room for the hymns, we may move them elsewhere some weeks. While there are other such prayers that serve the same purpose, these were written by Saint Thomas Aquinas. They are even in the Roman Missal, the book on the altar that the priest uses for Mass.

On a personal note, I started praying these prayers when I was in my early 20s, as they were in the Mass resource at my parish. I found them helpful in deepening my own devotion to Jesus and growing closer to Him through the Mass.

This is a quote from Saint John Vianney, the Patron Saint of Priests and a pastor to a small village in France in the 1800s called Ars, about the Holy Eucharist:

“Our Lord is hidden there, waiting for us to come and visit Him, and make our request to Him. See how good He is! He accommodates Himself to our weakness. In Heaven, where we shall be glorious and triumphant, we shall see Him in all His glory. If He had presented Himself before us in that glory now, we should not have dared to approach Him; but He hides Himself, like a person in a prison, who might say to us, ‘You do not see me, but that is no matter; ask of me all you wish and I will grant it.’ He is there in the Sacrament of His love, sighing and interceding incessantly with His Father for sinners.”
