
Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 6, 2025





From our Pastor

Father Michael Roche

I hope you all are enjoying a beautiful July 4th weekend! I have been blessed with many meetings and visits with you as I come upon 11 months of being your pastor. I am always available to chat and can be reached at

I'm praying for a great week of Vacation Bible School! If you haven't signed up yet, I'm sure your child can still participate.

This is the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, and the first Sunday the priest wears green vestments since March. There's a danger that the word *ordinary* in English carries a connotation of humdrum or boring. If you told someone you had an "ordinary" July 4th weekend, they might feel bad for you. I found this helpful explanation of the season's name on the Ascension Press website:

"Ordinary Time is called 'ordinary' not because it is not special or less significant but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) nor in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent)."

This time is really when we live out what the other seasons prepare us for. For a long time in the Church, these Sundays were called the "Sundays after Pentecost," which I think helped us remember: We have received the Holy Spirit, and now we set the world on fire with His love, kindled within us!

We hear in the Gospel today about those who are sent out to proclaim that the Kingdom of God is at hand. This is still our work. We get to share with the world the Good News: now that Jesus has come, death has been conquered—and there is really nothing *ordinary* about reality at all! Vocations to the priesthood and religious life, as well as Christ-centered marriages, help the world know this truth. So please, pray for these!

Facilities Assessment Team Update

Thank you once again to all who participated in our parish-wide survey. The Facilities Assessment Team continues to carefully review your feedback to understand the needs and priorities of our parish community.

In addition to reviewing survey responses, we are awaiting a comprehensive report from PVE, an engineering firm that is currently assessing all parish buildings across both campuses. This assessment will inform us of any current or potential issues with the structures and a timeline of when any such issues would need to be addressed.

Together, the survey results and the facility assessment will help guide our next steps as we work toward both short-term improvements and long-term planning for our parish spaces. We look forward to keeping you updated as this important work continues.


Scam Alert: Phishing Emails

Be wary of urgent or unusual requests, especially those involving money or personal information. When in doubt, call the parish office to verify the message before responding. 


