This collection provides the bulk of the resources needed for the out reach to help the poor in our neighborhoods of Penn Hills, Monroeville and Pitcairn. We are grateful for your continuing support. The collection amounted to \$5279.50 and is most appreciated. Since the last collection in March, 2025, the Society has helped 87 people. The aid given amounted to \$11589. The Society members provided 140 service hours and traveled 186 miles in this mission of charity.


