

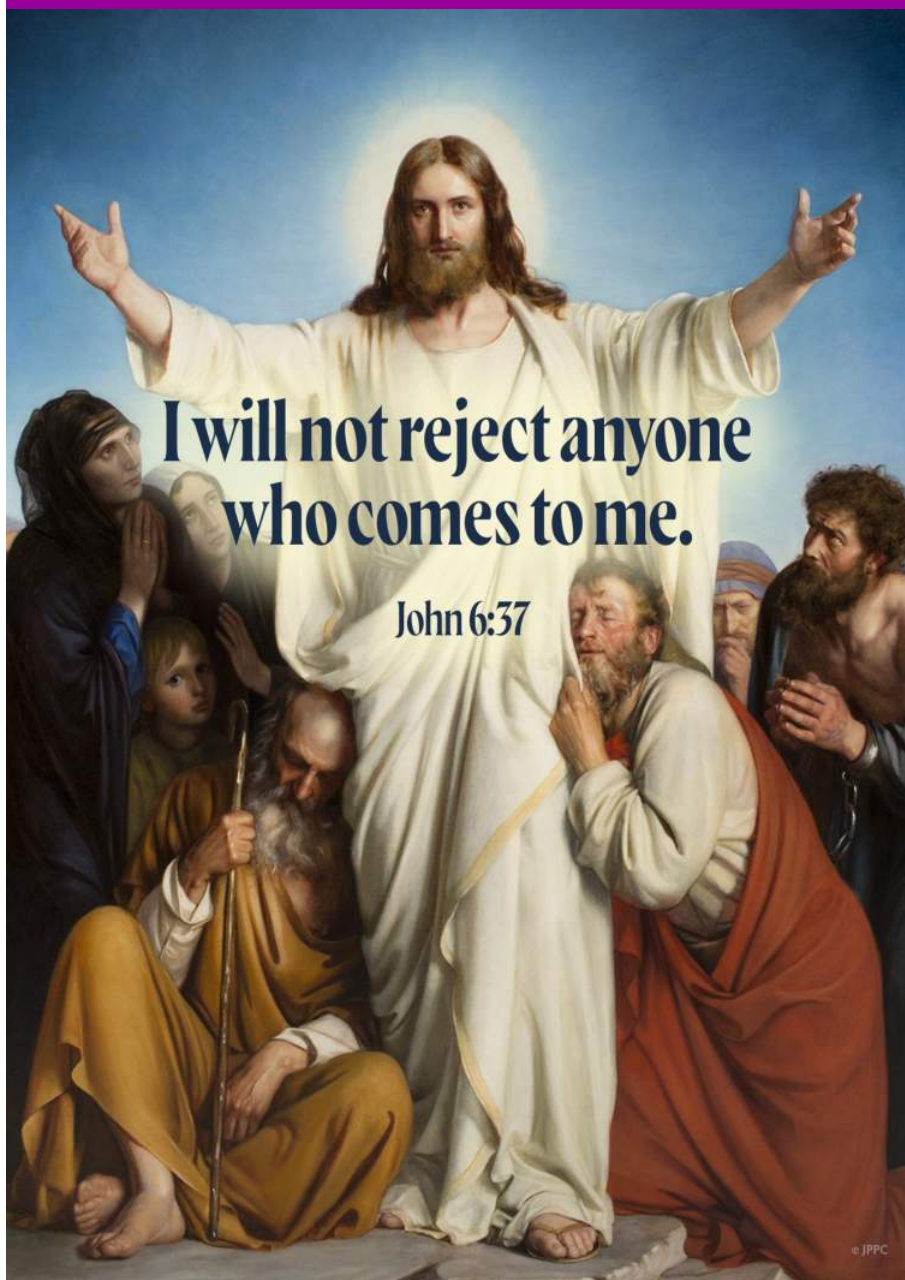

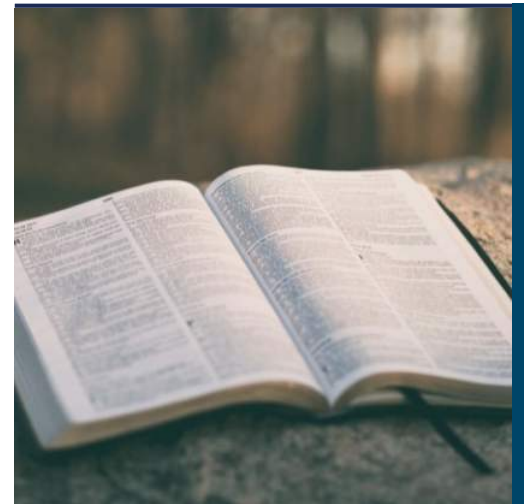


All Souls Day Remembrance Masses

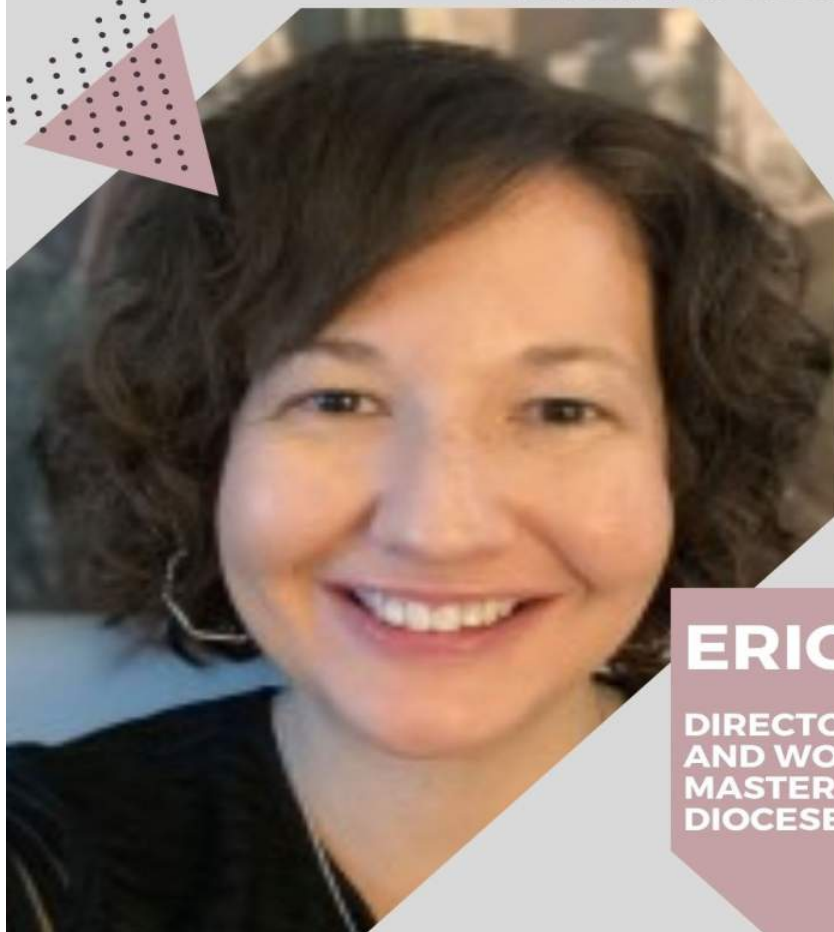

Reservations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

In an effort to try to accommodate the ever-increasing requests for Mass intentions, a change has been made this year as to the number of Masses a donor can request at this time. **Only one weekend Mass and one weekday Mass may be requested.**

As with any revised policy, we'll make adaptations as necessary. If it becomes clear that we can ease these restrictions, we will do so.
