

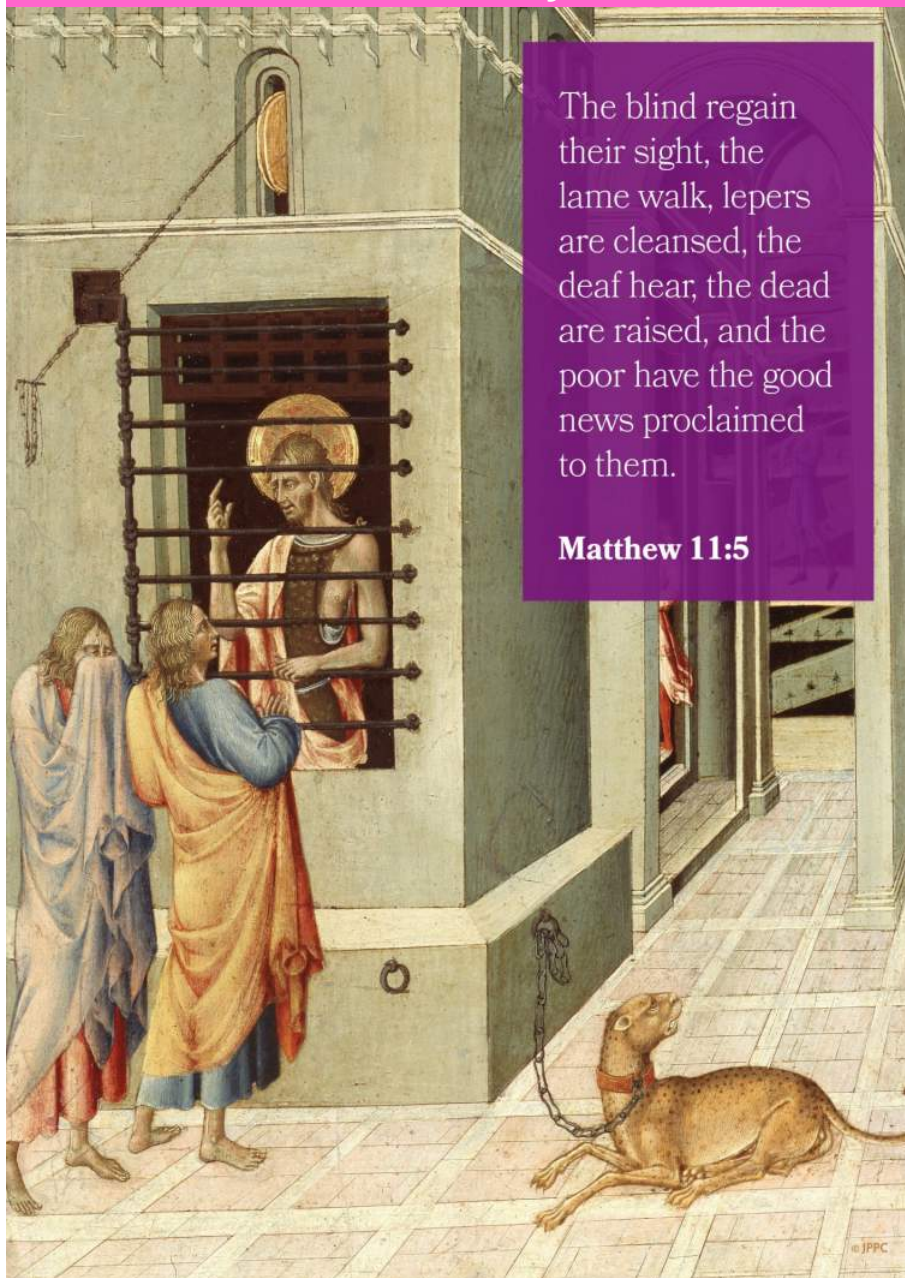

Gaudete: Rejoice!

Why Hearing the True Introit Matters Today

This Sunday is known throughout the Church as Gaudete Sunday, a name taken directly from the first word of the Entrance Chant: *Gaudete in Domino semper*, which means “Rejoice in the Lord always.”

A few weeks ago, we reflected on why at Christ the Divine Shepherd we sing the proper chants of the Mass, the very texts assigned by the Church for each liturgy. Today provides a perfect example of why this matters. The Church does not call this “Rejoice Sunday” because of a general theme or a popular hymn, but because the Introit itself begins with *Gaudete* and sets the tone for the entire celebration. *Gaudete in Domino semper* comes from Saint Paul’s Letter to the Philippians. These words were written from prison, yet they overflow with confident joy because St. Paul knows that Christ is near. The chant’s gentle melody from our Source and Summit Missal expresses that same quiet joy: not loud excitement, but the deep, steady rejoicing of a heart anchored in hope.

This Introit does more than simply begin Mass for us today; it reveals the meaning of the whole celebration. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states that the Entrance Chant is intended to open the celebration, express the day’s character, and foster the unity of those gathered (GIRM 47). The very name Gaudete Sunday comes from our chant text. Without hearing it, we may miss the Church’s proclamation at the doorway of the liturgy. In many places, where the propers are omitted, the faithful never actually hear the scriptural and theological text that gives this Sunday its identity. But here, we allow the liturgy to speak in its own voice.

Hymns can be beautiful and fitting, but they are secondary. The propers are the voice of the Church for a particular day, drawn from Scripture and tradition. When we sing the Introit, we are not choosing a theme for the Mass; we are receiving the one the Church has already chosen for us. The Third Sunday of Advent demonstrates this in a clear and powerful way. Through the Introit, the Church commands us to rejoice in the very first word of the Mass, tells us why we rejoice because “the Lord is near,” and even gives Gaudete Sunday its very name through this ancient chant dating back over a thousand years.

As we move deeper into Advent, the Church pauses today to remind us that Christian joy does not wait for perfect circumstances. It grows in the midst of longing, preparation, and hope. The Introit proclaims this with simplicity and clarity: “Rejoice in the Lord always, the Lord is near.” By singing the propers, we allow the liturgy to form our hearts from the very moment we begin. Today, be formed in joy.

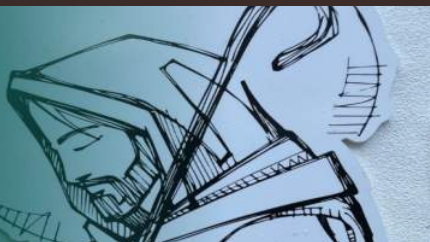
