Ordinary Time: Ordered, Not Ordinary

The Work of Formation in Daily Life

Last week, the Church entered Ordinary Time. This week, we celebrate the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, a season often misunderstood because of its name. In everyday language, ordinary can sound unremarkable. In the Church's calendar, however, Ordinary Time is anything but.

The word comes from the Latin *ordo*, meaning order or sequence. Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" because its weeks are numbered and ordered, not because they lack importance. It is the season in which the Church walks steadily with Christ through His public ministry and forms us gradually in the life of discipleship.

That quiet work of formation is reflected in the hymn *Be Thou My Vision*, which we sing this weekend. Rather than focusing on a single moment or emotion, *Be Thou My Vision* is a prayer of orientation. It asks that God shape how we see, think, and live, precisely the kind of prayer Ordinary Time invites us to pray week after week.

The text of the hymn comes from an early Irish prayer, written for daily devotion. Its endurance over centuries reminds us that faith is shaped not all at once, but through steady attention to God over time. The tune to which we sing this hymn, known as SLANE, also has Irish roots. Named after the Hill of Slane, a site closely associated with Saint Patrick, the melody carries with it a sense of history. Like the text itself, the tune has endured not because it seeks attention, but because it supports the lyrics and invites the heart to dwell calmly on God. It is especially fitting, then, to sing an Irish prayer at CDS, a parish blessed with an Irish deacon, our own Deacon Mike, whose faithful and hard working presence over many years reflects exactly the kind of perseverance this hymn expresses.

This emphasis on steady growth fits well with Catholic Schools Week. Catholic education, like Ordinary Time, unfolds through discipline, perseverance, and a shared commitment to truth. Its purpose is not only education, but the growth of faith, character, and love of God.

Ordinary Time reminds us that most of the Christian life is lived not in constant celebration or dramatic turning points, but in faithfulness, routine, and growth. It is a season that teaches us the value of showing up, listening, and allowing Christ to form us gradually, knowing that much of the Church's life is sustained by those who quietly and consistently show up. Ordinary Time is not ordinary at all. It is ordered time, time shaped by the Church so that faith may mature, and our vision may slowly become Christ's own.

Be Thou My Vision

Be Thou my vision, O Lord of my heart. Let nothing else be all else to me except what comes from You. Be my best thought by day and by night, waking or sleeping, Your presence my light. Be my wisdom and my true word. Be with me always, and may I remain in You. Be my Father, and let me be Your child. Dwell within me, and let me dwell in You.

Be my strength in battle and my protection in danger. Be my dignity and my joy. Be my shelter and my strong tower. Raise my heart toward heaven, O Power of my life. Let riches and empty praise mean nothing to me. You alone are my inheritance, now and always. Be first in my heart, O High King of heaven. After victory is won, may I reach the joys of heaven, O bright Sun of heaven. Heart of my own heart, whatever may come, still be my vision, O Ruler of all.

Called by Name

This January, the Diocese of Pittsburgh introduced Called by Name, a diocesan vocation initiative that invites parishioners to help encourage young men to consider God's call to the priesthood. Parishioners are asked to prayerfully reflect on the men in their parish, school, or family who demonstrate strong faith, leadership, and a generous spirit of service. These are the qualities that often signal openness to a vocation to the priesthood. This weekend, Called by Name response cards will be available in the pews at all Masses. Parishioners may write the name (s) of men they believe God may be calling and return the completed cards in the collection basket. All submitted names will be shared with the Diocesan Vocations Office. Each man recommended will receive a personal letter of encouragement from Bishop Eckman, along with an invitation to attend the Saint Andrew Dinner on March 1, an informal evening for men to learn more about priestly discernment. Called By Name is not about pressure or commitment, it is about encouragement, prayer, and helping young men recognize that the Church sees their gifts. Your prayerful suggestion may be the gentle invitation that helps someone listen more closely to God's call. All parishioners are encouraged to participate through prayer, reflection, and support for vocations within our Church.

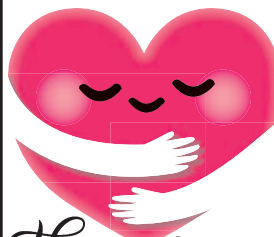
