And now, O Lord GOD, you are God, and your words are true, and you have promised this good thing to your servant. 2 Samuel 7:28

In this context, the promise that David is speaking about is that his descendant would build a house for the Lord. While that applies directly to Solomon building the first Temple, it also carries that Jesus built a new house for the Lord through the New Covenant of His Blood. In both cases, this became a dwelling place for God. The Temple contained the Ark of the Covenant which was kept in the Holy of Holies and was thought to be where God dwelt. But in the latter case, Jesus came to dwell among us as Flesh and establish a new Presence through the Holy Spirit and the Eucharist.
