In the encyclical, Laudato si [Praised Be], Pope Francis issued a call to action, framing climate change as a social justice issue. He focused in particular on access to fresh water, which he called a fundamental human right, and warned that the poor and marginalized groups are often overlooked, yet the first affected. Christiana Zenner, Ph.D., Associate Professor of Theology, Science and Ethics in the Department of Theology at Fordham University, will speak about the ecological turn in Catholic Social Teaching and the interconnectedness of access to water and justice in global economies. She will also suggest what needs to be done to improve access to safe water throughout the world.


