Reminder: Good Friday is a day of Fast and Abstinence.

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence from all meat. Except for a serious reason, all persons 14 years old and above are bound by this law.

Ash Wednesday (February 14) & Good Friday (March 30) are also days of fast. Those of age 18 until the day after one's 59th birthday are bound by this law. On these two days, one full meatless meal may be eaten. Two other meatless meals may also be taken sufficient to maintain strength, but together they should not equal a full meal. Liquids, including milk and fruit juices may be taken between meals. If health or ability to work is affected, the law does not oblige.

Subject: End of Seasonal Liturgical Restrictions - March 19.

Dear Father/Parish Administrator,

I am happy to share with you that Bishop McGrath has lifted the liturgical adaptations that we have instituted during the cold/flu season.

Effective next Monday, March 19, the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, we can return to our normal liturgical practices.

Please remind your parishioners to continue to remain vigilant if they have cold/cough/flu symptoms and to stay home if they are aware of any such symptoms.

This is especially important as we hopefully near the end of long and deadly flu season.

I hope that the resumption of normal liturgical practices, especially during the coming Holy Week and Easter celebrations, brings as much joy to you as it does to me.

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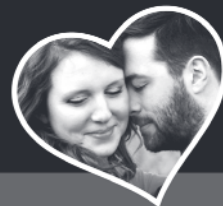
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
