- ☐ Find objects that are the following shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle.
- ☐ Draw a picture for each of the following addition facts and solve.

- ☐ Draw a picture for each of the following subtraction facts and solve.

- ☐ Draw 8 squares.
- ☐ Find something that is long and something that is short.
