How do we begin to respond to the many urgent charity requests in our mail every week?

Well, that gorgeous text from Deuteronomy (30:10-14) hints that it's not so overwhelming that we should say, "Oh, the ways to help are too mysterious and remote for us. We're going to hide and pretend we don't know."

My current favorite poet, Lin-Manuel Miranda, posts at least one photograph every week of some event somewhere which should touch us and break our hearts. Sometimes the caption is *This happened today. Don't look away.*


But of course, I do look away, often, because sometimes looking is just too terrible. But, yes, that little voice inside compels me to know what is *already in my mouth and in my heart*. I know what I can do, the action I can take, to help someone, somewhere. *I have only to carry it out.*

Last year I took the MOST fantastic class on migration at our parish. It was educational and utterly inspiring. But as we were all packing up our materials, our instructor Ann said, "Wait a minute. Nobody leaves until you've pledged to an action that you will take." Gulp. You mean I actually have to DO something? Can't I just read and watch sad videos? Isn't being educated on migration issues enough? Her emphatic "no" alerted me that I had encountered someone who was going to actually check my homework, actually gently insist that the cost of the class is discipleship.

I'll let Lin-Manuel have the last words: "You cannot let all the world's tragedies into your heart. You'll drown. But the ones you do let in should count. Let them manifest action."

Is there a good work your heart and your mouth know you should do?

Pues, ese texto tan hermoso de Deuteronomio (30: 10-14) nos insinúa que no es tan abrumante poder decir, "Oh, las maneras de ayudar son demasiado misteriosas y remotas para nosotros. Escondámonos y hagamos como que no sabemos."

Mi actual poeta favorito, Lin-Manuel Miranda, publica al menos una fotografía cada semana de algún evento en algún lugar que debería conmovernos y quebrantar nuestros corazones. A veces el subtítulo dice *Esto sucedió hoy. No voltees la mirada.*

Pero por supuesto que volteo la mirada, a menudo, porque a veces solo el ver es demasiado terrible. Sin embargo esa vocecita dentro de mí me obliga a reconocer lo que *ya está en mi boca y en mi corazón.* Yo sé lo que puedo hacer, la acción que puedo tomar, para ayudarle a alguien, en algún lado. *Solo tengo que llevarlo a cabo.*

El año pasado tomé una clase que daban en mi parroquia TAN estupenda acerca de la migración. Fue educacional y totalmente inspiradora. Pero cuando la clase se acabó y todos nos preparábamos para irnos, nuestra instructora Ann nos dijo, “Esperen un minuto. Nadie se va de aquí hasta que se hayan comprometido a tomar algún tipo de acción.” Tragué saliva. ¿Quiere decir que de verdad tenemos que HACER algo? ¿No es suficiente leer y ver videos tristes? ¿Qué no es suficiente con educarnos acerca de los temas de migración? Su rotundo “no” me alertó de que me encontraba frente a alguien quien de verdad iba a revisarme la tarea, de verdad gentilmente insistiría en que el costo de la clase está en su discipulado.

Le otorgo el derecho de las últimas palabras a Lin-Manuel: “No puedes permitir que todas las tragedias del mundo entren en tu corazón. Te ahogarías. Pero las que permites dentro deben contar. Permítelas manifestarse en acción.”

¿Hay alguna buena obra que tu corazón y tu boca saben que deberías hacer?
