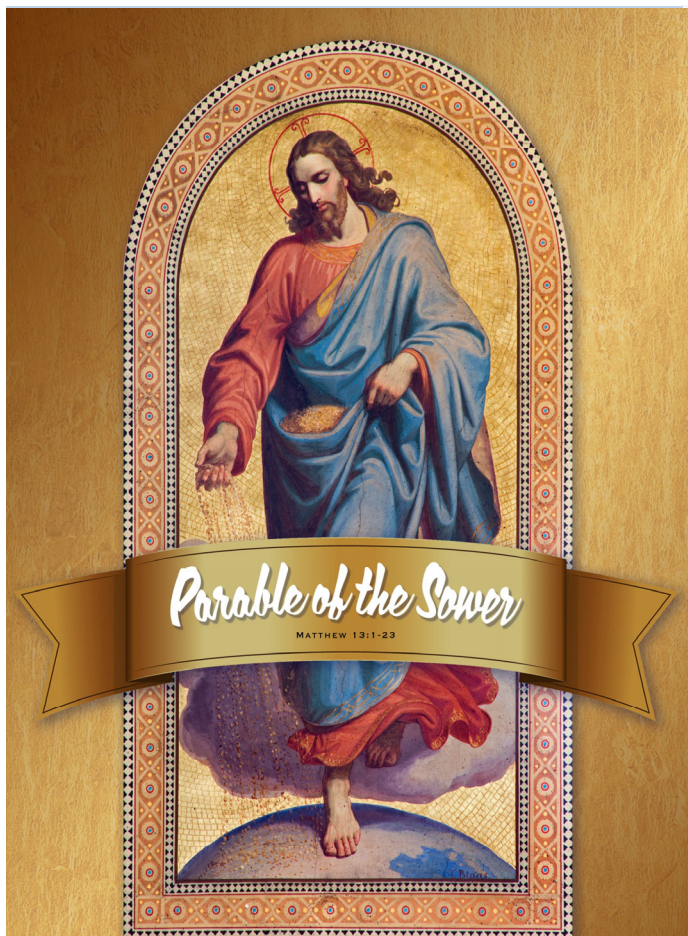

NEW PARISHIONERS:

Our Mother of Good Counsel warmly welcomes new parishioners. We believe in the "Stewardship Program" committed to serving God through offering our gifts of time, talents, and treasure for the good of our parish and those in need. We ask you to register by completing a registration form available in the parish office during regular office hours or on-line at our website. Parishioners moving should notify the parish office of any change in address or phone number.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Parents are asked to register for Baptism at the parish office three months in advance and must participate in our Baptismal preparatory program.

Ordinarily, we celebrate Baptism during any weekend Mass on the second and fourth Sundays of the month.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Saturday: 11:30 - 12:00 Noon or by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:

Couples desiring to be married at OMGCP parish must contact the parish office at least six months prior or upon their formal engagement to set up a time and date for your wedding celebration.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

If you would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the parish office to schedule a time.

If you are ill or unable to come to Mass for any period of time, please call the Parish Office (610-525-0147), and we will be happy to visit and bring Communion to you.



Dear Parishioners & Friends,

August is a transition month, especially for our high school seniors, who are headed off to college. Some will be moving far from home, while others will stay close enough so that they can remain connected to their friends and family on a more regular basis. Others may have chosen to join the workforce or military service. In any case, this is an important shift from living under the guidance and care of their parents to a more independent lifestyle away from what they would ordinarily experience as a high school student.

College is truly a time of personal, emotional, and spiritual growth. Making daily decisions related to just about every aspect of their lives can sometimes be overwhelming, while at other times, a refreshing way to move forward as a young adult. National statistics tell us that many college students find this newfound freedom to be a welcome change, while others seem to be affected negatively due to the anxiety and tension that stems from having to make so many decisions on their own.

As a pastor, I am extremely sensitive to what transpires as young men and women head off to unknown adventures, relationships, and at times, the isolation that comes with moving away from home. This also can have a huge impact on the family. In some cases, this leaves a unique void in the lives of parents and siblings who have become accustomed to having their teenage son or daughter around and under their wings. Having worked in both a high school for many years and at Villanova University in Campus Ministry, I have met with many parents and college students to help them adjust to this radical change for them and their families.

With this transition in mind, I would like to invite all our college-age students, especially those headed off for the first time, to join us for the 11:30 AM Mass on August 6, followed by a luncheon so that we too can offer prayers and blessings to those who will be moving on to this new phase of life. I would encourage the parents of our high school graduates to invite and encourage them to join us that day as we properly share in sending them off to what will eventually be the blueprint of their future if they maturely approach their studies, their new relationships, and the freedom to make wise decisions each day. It is no secret that many of our high school students have chosen not to worship with us regularly, but that only makes our desire to pray with and for them more important.

I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible on August 6, as some of you will be headed off early in August for orientation to your new and temporary home. **Please RSVP to the parish office or directly to me if you can join us on August 6 at the 11:30 AM Mass, followed by some Augustinian Hospitality as we celebrate the milestones of your high school accomplishments.**

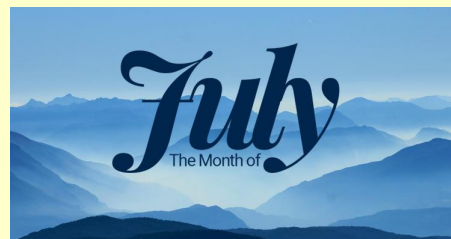
To all our high school graduates, we will remember you in prayer as you find your way post-high school into the many phases of young adult life. May the Lord watch over you and keep you safe.

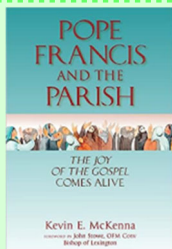
For our Space themed Vacation Bible Camp this year, we are looking for donations of the following items. If you have any that you are willing to donate or part ways with, we would be most grateful.
