Incomplete applications will not be considered.

August, 2024	Name / Address of institution to mail scholarship check

Scholarship payments checks are mailed directly to the University or Catholic High School. You must provide the institution's name and address no later than August 15, 2024. If you choose to discontinue with pursuit of college education, or decide to attend a public or non-Catholic high school, you will forfeit the scholarship. If you are a college student who has not determined where you will matriculate, you must notify the Scholarship Committee by August 15, 2024, by letter or email to the parish office (not by phone). If you state your intention to enroll in a Catholic University, but enroll in a secular university instead, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to re-examine the scholarship award.
