



serving the poor in the Caribbean, Africa, Southeast Asia, and Central and South America.







Project. Rather than trying to convince others to act, they have taken it upon them-

They are working to regenerate the soil on Allen's property and have created a large vegetable garden, which the proceeds are donated to the local food bank. They are also trying to help reshape the forest lands on the property to make them more fire resistant and thus making the local Colfax community safer.

This group has also expanded to other areas in the greater region.

Jim Thompson, Founder & CEO of This! Is What We Did asks "What will you tell your grandchildren when they ask what you did to avert the climate crisis?" 
