#### What the Council does

- Serves as an advisory group to the Pastor
- Discusses the pastoral needs of the Parish
- Enhances the process of developing pastoral programs and evaluating their effectiveness
- Accomplishes this through Prayer, Listening and Dialogue
- Is presided by the Pastor
- Is not a decision making body, but rather provides recommendations to the Pastor

### Why would you want to serve

- If you want to work directly with our Pastor, learn about his pastoral priorities, and assist in addressing them
- If you have identified pastoral needs in our parish and want to work addressing those needs

## **Composition**

- Nine (9) Members, elected from the Congregation at Large
- One (1) Representative from the Youth Group
- Our Pastor, Father Stanley
- Council member names are listed in the Parish Council page of the parish's website

#### **Member Commitment**

- Period of Service three (3) years, with monthly 2 hr meetings ten (10) months of the year (no meetings during July or August)
- Meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month, starting at 7PM
- Member Rotation three (3) new members rotate into the council every year, with three (3) current members rotating out

#### **New Member Selection Process**

- October: Bulletin and pulpit announcements are made, requesting that the congregation nominate candidates
- October Early December: candidates fill out and submit a brief application it asks about their involvement in the parish and why are they interested in serving in the council. Deadline for submitting applications is the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> week in December.
- December Council Meeting: all the applications are prayerfully reviewed by the current council members. Council discusses the merits of each one of the candidates and selects three (3) new members and one (1) alternate.
- December: All the candidates are notified of the selection results
- January: the three new members are installed into the council during the January council meeting and start serving their terms. The terms of the three outgoing members conclude.
