How Do You Cooperate With God's grace?

Dear Friends at Christ Our Hope,

When striving to understand the meaning of a passage in the Gospels it is always best to read it in the context of what came just before it.

In the case of the the miracle of the loaves and fishes heard this weekend, we read about the murder of John the Baptist during Herod's banquet. Herod's evil banquet was the human expression of arrogance, lust, conspiracy and murder.

The banquet Jesus offers is one of healing, faithful obedience to God, and caring for the needs of others through the sharing of food to the 5000 who gathered to hear Jesus speak. What a stark contrast of human behavior.

The important take away for us from this weekend's Gospel message is how we cooperate (or not) with God's grace as we deal with the overwhelming challenges each day. Is our response life-giving or life-taking? It's a choice.

Sunday Music Article from Dr. Savage

This Sunday the music recalls the Gospel story of the Woman at the Well. A small ensemble of women from the Choir of Hope will musically "play the role" of the Samaritan woman who became one of the first to spread the Good News.

Women's voices will sing By flowing waters the Lord has planted his saints (Psalm 1); women's voices will lead us in Isaiah's great canticle Come to the water. During Communion, we will hear a telling of the Samaritan woman's story in the song As when the sun shines down at noon.

The Gospel writer John was definite about the time: "The hour was about noon." In some Mediterranean areas, the noon time air in the summer is filled to over-flowing with the sound of Cicada, the intense, high-energy sound of insect musicians. Most Cicada vibrate their drum like tymbals at night, but not the bold Cicada of parts of the Mediterranean world who cease singing as the sun sets. If you have not experienced this sound you can get a hint of it here. It is this sound: the incessantly insistent sound of mid-day that was the musical accompaniment of the Samaritan woman's encounter with Jesus at noon.

Our singing women will not suggest the musicmaking of Cicada, but perhaps you can create the accompaniment in your mind's ear. We look forward to you joining and enjoying this week's Sunday 7PM Mass.



Scrutiny Celebration

This Sunday at the 7 pm Mass, our **Elect Julie Poliak and Phuong Nguyen** are in their final intense preparation for their baptisms, beginning with a Scrutiny Celebration.

Scrutinies are usually celebrated during Sundays in Lent. RCIA, no. 141: "The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good....to give them strength in Christ...and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all."

Our Elects' preparation continues with an all-day retreat on Saturday, August 8th, before their baptism, confirmation and first communion on Sunday, August 9th. Please continue to keep Julie and Phuong in your prayers over these next two weeks. As we will not all be able to introduce ourselves in person, we have created a virtual introduction board. You are encouraged to leave a message here, welcoming Julie and Phuong to Christ Our Hope Church and our community.
